Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

Today's first reading from Isaiah arises out of the ordeal of the people of Jerusalem and Judea as they anticipate the end of seventy years of exile in Babylon. Their sufferings and their oppression will end, and they are promised joy like that of a great wedding upon returning to their homeland. Although this passage is probably set in the early sixth century B.C., it is free of historical particulars.

Accordingly, the Church has understood its imagery universally, as it proclaims God's promise of healing, hope, and happiness for all peoples, in this world and in the next. When read against this background, the story of Jesus' turning water into wine at the wedding at Cana becomes a revelation of God's presence in the person of Jesus, making these promises real for us in the here and now, in the transformation of our own lives.

As Catholics, we see all of life sacramentally. God reaches us through His word that we hear and the sacraments that we celebrate, especially the Eucharist. Everything that is part of nature – trees and crops, fruit and vegetables, water and sunshine – are provided for us by God that we might have life. The richness and beauty of our world is a sign of God's bounteous love for us.

Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us.

Queridas familias del Inmaculado Corazon de Maria,

La primera lectura de hoy de Isaías surge del sufrimiento del pueblo de Jerusalén y de Judea cuando ellos anticiparon el final de los setenta años de exilio en Babilonia. Sus sufrimientos y su opresión terminarán, y se les promete una alegría como la de una boda espléndida al regresar a su patria. Aunque es probable que este pasaje sucedió a principios del siglo VI AC, carece de los detalles históricos.

En este sentido, la Iglesia ha entendido sus metáforas de forma universal, ya que proclama la promesa de Dios de curación, esperanza y felicidad para todos los pueblos, en este mundo y en el otro. Cuando se lee este contexto, la historia de Jesús convirtiendo el agua en vino en las bodas de Canaán se convierte en una revelación de la presencia de Dios en la persona de Jesús, haciendo que estas promesas sean verdaderas para nosotros aquí y ahora, en la transformación de nuestras propias vidas.

Como católicos, vemos toda la vida de forma sacramental. Dios llega a nosotros a través de su palabra que escuchamos y de los sacramentos que celebramos, especialmente la Eucaristía. Todo lo que forma parte de la naturaleza –árboles y cultivos, frutas y verduras, agua y sol- nos lo proporciona Dios para que tengamos vida. La riqueza y la belleza de nuestro mundo es un signo del amor generoso de Dios por nosotros.

Inmaculado Corazon de Maria, ruega por nosotros.

January 22 Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM), no. 373, designates January 22 as a particular day of prayer and penance, called the "Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children": "In all the Dioceses of the United States of America, January 22 (or January 23, when January 22 falls on a Sunday) shall be observed as a particular day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion."

Evangelio

Jn 2, 1-11

En aquel tiempo, hubo una boda en Caná de
Galilea, a la cual asistió la madre de Jesús. Este y
sus discípulos también fueron invitados. Como
llegara a faltar el vino, María le dijo a Jesús: "Ya
no tienen vino". Jesús le contestó: "Mujer, ¿qué
podemos hacer tú y yo? Todavía no llega mi hora".
Pero ella dijo a los que servían: "Hagan lo que él
les diga".

Había allí seis tinajas de piedra, de unos cien litros
cada una, que servían para las purificaciones de
los judíos. Jesús dijo a los que servían: "Llenen de

agua esas tinajas". Y las llenaron hasta el borde.
Entonces les dijo: "Saquen ahora un poco y
llévenselo al mayordomo".
Así lo hicieron, y en cuanto el mayordomo probó
el agua convertida en vino, sin saber su
procedencia, porque sólo los sirvientes la sabían,
llamó al novio y le dijo: "Todo el mundo sirve
primero el vino mejor, y cuando los invitados ya
han bebido bastante, se sirve el corriente. Tú, en
cambio, has guardado el vino mejor hasta ahora".

Esto que hizo Jesús en Caná de Galilea fue el
primero de sus signos. Así manifestó su gloria y
sus discípulos creyeron en él.

There was a wedding at Cana in Galilee,
and the mother of Jesus was there.
Jesus and his disciples were also invited to the
wedding.
When the wine ran short,

the mother of Jesus said to him,
"They have no wine."
And Jesus said to her,
"Woman, how does your concern affect me?
My hour has not yet come."
His mother said to the servers,
"Do whatever he tells you."
Now there were six stone water jars there for
Jewish ceremonial washings,
each holding twenty to thirty gallons.
Jesus told them, "Fill the jars with water."
So they filled them to the brim.
Then he told them, "Draw some out now and
take it to the headwaiter." So they took it.
And when the headwaiter tasted the water that
had become wine,
without knowing where it came from
— although the servers who had drawn the water
knew —, the headwaiter called the bridegroom
and said to him, "Everyone serves good wine
first, and then when people have drunk freely, an
inferior one;
but you have kept the good wine until now."
Jesus did this as the beginning of his signs at
Cana in Galilee and so revealed his glory,
and his disciples began to believe in him.

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

It was several years ago now, but the scene is still vivid in my mind. My son stood confidently in front of the altar as the music rose in a crescendo and his bride stepped into sight. The love and joy he felt trickled down his cheek as she walked down the aisle. He broke into a smile as she joined him, and proudly took her hand to promise to become one with her forever. Isaiah writes: “As a bridegroom rejoices in his bride so shall your God rejoice in you.” Isaiah was talking about the nation of Israel, but God loves and rejoices in each of his children and wants us to know the joy of being loved by him. He generously shares his gifts with us, “different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit,” St. Paul explains to the Corinthians. *All* spiritual gifts come from God, and *all* are important and necessary: “To each individual, the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit.” God’s gifts are distributed uniquely to each person to use in our own unique way to “announce his salvation, day after day,” and invite others to discover the joy of his great love.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

You are a masterpiece! This message was conveyed at the camp our diocese held each year to help teens recognize that they are God’s beloved sons and daughters, called and gifted by the Holy Spirit to be missionary disciples. Discerning what our gifts are and how to use them can be challenging. The Gospel about the wedding at Cana offers an interesting guide. Mary tells the waiters, “Do whatever he tells you.” By reserving time for listening and not speaking during prayer, we can hear what Jesus is “telling” us. Jesus then says to the waiters, “Fill the jars with water.” We can “fill our jars” with the knowledge of how to live as disciples by reflecting on Scripture. Finally, Jesus tells the waiters, “Draw some out.” We can “draw” on his love for strength and courage when we need it, but more importantly, we are called to “draw some out” to share with others. In sharing the “good wine,” the Good News of Jesus Christ, others will begin to believe in him, too.

PRAYER As the new year gets under way, devote time to discerning the unique spiritual gifts, or charisms, you have been given. Make time for silent prayer and reflecting on Scripture each day.
