Dear Families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

The readings share a very clear common theme: God chooses the side of the humble and oppressed. Zephaniah calls the humble and righteous to seek refuge in God, knowing that God cares for them. Jesus also proclaims that these same people will be the first to inherit the kingdom of God. Reflecting the Christian community in Corinth, Paul recognizes that God chooses "the weak of the world to put to shame the strong."

The Beatitudes are some of the most comforting and encouraging words in the gospels, and a reminder of God's desire to take care of us when we are at our most shattered. Life can be full of challenges, heartbreaks, and drudgery. Jesus wants to meet us precisely in the battle, promising us that the kingdom of God is there. Trusting in God's love and mercy, we can follow Jesus' teachings because we know that God will be with us in whatever difficulties life presents.

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

There have been many times when I have experienced “imposter syndrome” in my work, where I doubt my own ability. In these times, I often looked to others to try to determine if I was doing enough. But instead of giving me the validation and encouragement I was seeking, this act of comparison frequently led to dissatisfaction. I began to wish I was more like others — more outgoing, more disciplined, more organized. But who I am and the gifts that I have to offer are exactly what I am being called to give in my vocation. Saint Paul reminds us in his First Letter to the Corinthians that we were not called because we possess a specific talent or personality; we have been called to bear witness to the work Christ is doing in us. And this witness comes from living our vocation authentically, with the gifts we naturally possess. When we not only accept but love and value our unique qualities, we give glory to the One who so lovingly and perfectly created us.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

In proclaiming the beatitudes, Christ reveals that those who will experience the rewards of heaven aren’t those we might consider “blessed” by human standards. What our culture values as markers of success and happiness are not always what is valued in the kingdom of God. Indeed, the joys of life in the kingdom are deeper than those here on earth; we were created for fulfillment greater than what this world can offer. Therefore, we must live confidently in the hope of Christ’s promises instead of comparing ourselves to others who might appear more successful. And as we live our vocation, we are called to live out the countercultural message of the beatitudes — a radical trust in the eternal promises of God in spite of earthly poverty, grief, or persecution. In doing so, we invite others to see and experience the joy of the abundant life that Christ proclaims.

REFLECT

As we go through life, there can be times when we feel unprepared for the vocation God has called us to. Consider how these feelings of inadequacy may be an invitation for us to rely more fully on Christ working within us. Bring this to prayer and ask the Lord to reveal how he may be using this particular circumstance to draw us closer to him.

St. Agatha – February 5 Virgin, Martyr, Patroness of Nurses

On February 5th, the Church celebrates one of the early Virgin Martyrs, St. Agatha, who is named in the Roman Canon (Eucharistic Prayer I). She was born in 231 in Sicily. St. Agatha was one of the most venerated virgin martyrs of antiquity.

Exact biographical data on Agatha is challenging to come by. Most of what is known about Agatha comes from hagiography. Over the centuries, many saints have written about her, including St. Aldhelm, St. Methodius, St. Isidore of Seville, and Pope Damasus.

Agatha was born into a wealthy, illustrious family. She was consecrated to God at age 15 when she made a vow of virginity to Christ. In doing so, she rejected the advances of the Roman prefect of Sicily, Quintianus. At first, he believed she would abandon her vow and marry him. She never wavered, however. Rejected, he reported her to the authorities for being a Christian.

Decius was the emperor, and he initiated persecutions of Christians in 250.

At the prospect of torture and death, Quintianus expected Agatha to give in and marry him. Her resolute Christian faith defeated him once again. He sent her as a prisoner to be kept in a brothel for a month. She remained a committed Christian.

Angered by his inability to change her mind, Quintianus sent her to a Roman prison and tortured her cruelly. Despite this, her faith never wavered. He realized that he would never be successful and sentenced her to be burned at the stake. An earthquake prevented this sentence from being carried out, and she was returned to prison instead. St. Peter is said to have appeared to her and healed her body from the wounds of torture.

St. Agatha is the patron saint of breast cancer patients, bakers, nurses, martyrs, virgins, rape and torture victims, firefighters, burn victims, and earthquakes. Due to her popularity, she is also a patron of various cities throughout Europe.

Santa Águeda – 5 de febrero Virgin, Mártir, Patrona de las Enfermeras

El 5 de febrero, la Iglesia celebra a una de las primeras Vírgenes Mártires, Santa Águeda, que aparece en el Canon Romano (Oración Eucarística I). Nació en el año 231 en Sicilia. Santa Águeda fue una de las vírgenes mártires más veneradas de la antigüedad.

Es difícil obtener datos biográficos exactos sobre Agatha. La mayor parte de lo que se sabe sobre Agatha proviene de la hagiografía. A lo largo de los siglos, muchos santos han escrito sobre ella, entre ellos San Aldhelm, San Metodio, San Isidoro de Sevilla y el Papa Dámaso.

Agatha nació en una familia adinerada e ilustre. Fue consagrada a Dios a los 15 años cuando hizo un voto de virginidad a Cristo. Al hacerlo, rechazó los avances del prefecto romano de Sicilia, Quintiano. Al principio, creyó que ella abandonaría su voto y se casaría con él. Sin embargo, nunca vaciló. Rechazada, la denunció a las autoridades por ser cristiana. Decio fue el emperador y inició persecuciones contra cristianos en 250.

Ante la perspectiva de la tortura y la muerte, Quintianus esperaba que Agatha cediera y se casara con él. Su firme fe cristiana lo derrotó una vez más. La envió prisionera para que la mantuvieran en un burdel durante un mes. Ella siguió siendo una cristiana comprometida.

Enfadado por su incapacidad para hacerle cambiar de opinión, Quintiano la envió a una prisión romana y la torturó cruelmente. A pesar de ello, su fe nunca flaqueó. Se dio cuenta de que nunca tendría éxito y la condenó a ser quemada en la hoguera. Un terremoto impidió que se cumpliera esta sentencia, y fue devuelto a prisión. Se dice que San Pedro se le apareció y curó su cuerpo de las heridas de la tortura.

Santa Águeda es la patrona de pacientes con cáncer de mama, panaderos, enfermeros, mártires, vírgenes, víctimas de violación y tortura, bomberos, quemaduras y terremotos. Debido a su popularidad, también es mecenas de varias ciudades de Europa.
