Dear Families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

The readings invite us to appreciate the beauty of God's law and our freedom to choose whether or not to follow it. The first encounter traces two paths: life and death, good and evil. The psalmist has chosen a path, asking for the grace to "walk in the law of the Lord." Paul articulates the mystery of God's wisdom that exists beyond those who seek only their own good. In the gospel, Jesus' expansion over God's law forces the bearer to decide: Will I obey God's commandments?

For many, certain church teachings can be a point of conflict, a genuine source of distress and frustration. At times, God's wisdom seems to be mysteriously above our own—this was certainly true for those who heard Jesus preach. In times when we struggle to follow, understand, or even believe in the teachings given by the church, we can approach the Holy Spirit with humility, asking for the grace to see as God sees.

This Wednesday, Ash Wednesday, is the beginning of Lent. Please see the Mass schedule for Ash Wednesday on page 10. No ashes will be permitted to go out of Church.

En el evangelio, la expansión de Jesús sobre la ley de Dios obliga al portador a decidir: ¿Obedeceré los mandamientos de Dios?

Para muchos, ciertas enseñanzas de la iglesia pueden ser un punto de conflicto, una fuente genuina de angustia y frustración. A veces, la sabiduría de Dios parece estar misteriosamente por encima de la nuestra—esto fue ciertamente cierto para quienes escucharon predicar a Jesús. En tiempos en los que nos cuesta seguir, entender o incluso creer en las enseñanzas dadas por la iglesia, podemos acercarnos al Espíritu Santo con humildad, pidiendo la gracia para ver como Dios ve.

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells his disciples that "unless your righteousness surpasses that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven." In Matthew 23:3-5, Jesus says, "Do and observe all things whatsoever [the scribes and Pharisees] tell you, but do not follow their example. For they preach but they do not practice ... All their works are performed to be seen." What Jesus is inviting us to see is that to authentically live the commandments requires more than mere external compliance with the letter of the law. It's also not about putting on a show so that others think we're "holy." Rather, it's about the quiet, inner transformation of our hearts. The Gospel tells us it's not enough that we avoid murder; God wants to free us from anger and wrath. It's not enough to avoid unfaithfulness in marriage; God wants to give us hearts that are pure and free from lust. Our task is to open our hearts to the transforming power of his commandments which, if we live them, lead us to fullness of life.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

In our second reading, St. Paul speaks about some challenges we face when sharing the faith with others. There are those who are unable to grasp God's wisdom, which is different from the wisdom of this age. God's wisdom is mysterious, hidden, and can only be understood and grasped through a revelation of the Spirit. This is an important concept for us as evangelizers. Sometimes no matter how hard we try, no matter how eloquent we are at explaining something, those who are not ready to receive what we have to share will not be able to receive it. In order for others to understand the Gospel, the Spirit must open their hearts to receive it. While we are responsible to share the Gospel as well as we're able, it is up to the person before us to respond to God's invitation.

PRAY

Accepting the Lord's teaching in the commandments requires humility, and understanding their true meaning and depth is the result of the Spirit's work in our lives. Ask the Holy Spirit to give you true insight to live the commandments with your whole heart. Consider using these lines from today's psalm in your prayer: "Open my eyes, that I may consider the wonders of your law. Instruct me, O Lord, in the way of your statutes, that I may exactly observe them. Give me discernment, that I may observe your law and keep it with all my heart."

St. Peter Damian – February 21

Bishop, Doctor of the Church

This week, Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of the penitential season of Lent. On Saturday, the Church recognizes Saint Peter Damian, who lived the Lenten practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving throughout his life.

Peter was born in 1007 in Ravenna, then part of the Papal States (now Italy). His parents died soon after, leaving him an orphan. He was taken in by an older brother and treated harshly, more like a slave than a brother. Another brother, Damianus, a priest, saw this and took over his care, beginning with education. Peter added his brother's name to his and excelled in his studies of theology and canon law.

By 25, Peter was a renowned teacher in Ravenna. Three years later, he gave up this comfortable, successful life to embrace an ascetical life as a monk in the Benedictine hermitage of Fonte Avellana. He embraced fasting and prayer. His extreme fasting led to health problems, and he was instructed to ease up.

He was tasked with lecturing his brother monks. Soon, he was requested to lecture to monks in neighboring monasteries. He was then appointed manager of the house by the prior, who designated him as his successor. In 1043, he became prior and remained so the rest of his life.

He was serious about monastic and clerical reform. Monasteries were lax in their prayers, penance, and service. Bishops and clerics were, at the time, given to marriage, simony, and corruption. He wrote and spoke against these evils at synods. In 1057, the abbot of the Benedictine Abbey of Monte Cassino was elected Pope Stephen IX. He elevated Peter to the rank of Bishop and Cardinal and appointed him Bishop of Ostia. Peter wanted to refuse, but the Pope saw the need for reforms in the curia and the Church, and Peter was to help with this.

He was also concerned with the faith of ordinary believers and worked to revitalize their faith. He wrote and preached on the Real Presence of Christ. He was allowed to retire as Bishop in 1067. He served as a Papal legate, sent to various hotspots to settle disputes and bring peace. He died in 1072 on his way back to Fonte Avellana from one of these trips.

San Pedro Damián – 21 de febrero

Obispo, Doctor de la Iglesia

El miércoles de esta semana es el Miércoles de Ceniza, el comienzo de la temporada penitencial de Cuaresma. El sábado, la Iglesia reconoce a San Pedro Damián, quien vivió las prácticas cuaresmales de oración, ayuno y limosna durante toda su vida.

Pedro nació en 1007 en Rávena, entonces parte de los Estados Pontificios (actual Italia). Sus padres murieron poco después, dejándole huérfano. Fue acogido por un hermano mayor y tratado con dureza, más como un esclavo que como un hermano. Otro hermano, Damiano, sacerdote, vio esto y se hizo cargo de su cuidado, comenzando por la educación. Pedro añadió el nombre de su hermano al suyo y se destacó en sus estudios de teología y derecho canónico.

A los 25 años, Pedro era un maestro reconocido en Rávena. Tres años después, abandonó esa vida cómoda y exitosa para abrazar una vida ascética como monje en la ermita benedictina de Fonte Avellana. Abrazó el ayuno y la oración. Su ayuno extremo le provocó problemas de salud, y se le indicó que bajara el ritmo.

Se le encargó dar lecciones a sus hermanos monjes. Poco después, le pidieron que diera conferencias a monjes en monasterios vecinos. Luego fue nombrado administrador de la casa por el Superior, quien le designó como su sucesor. En 1043, fue nombrado Superior de ese monasterio y permaneció en ese puesto el resto de su vida.

El tomo en serio la reforma monástica y clerical. Los monasterios eran laxos en sus oraciones, penitencia y servicio. En aquella época, obispos y clérigos estaban propensos al matrimonio, la simonía y la corrupción. Escribió y habló contra estos males en los sínodos. En 1057, el abad de la abadía benedictina de Montecassino fue elegido Papa Esteban IX. Elevó a Pedro al rango de obispo y cardenal y lo nombró obispo de Ostia. Pedro quiso negarse, pero el Papa vio la necesidad de reformas en la curia y la Iglesia, y Pedro debía ayudar en ello.

También se preocupaba por la fe de los creyentes comunes y trabajó para revitalizar su fe. Escribió y predicó sobre la Presencia Real de Cristo. Se le permitió retirarse como obispo en 1067. Sirvió como legado papal, enviado a varios puntos clave para resolver disputas y traer la paz. Murió en 1072 de regreso a Fonte Avellana en uno de estos viajes.

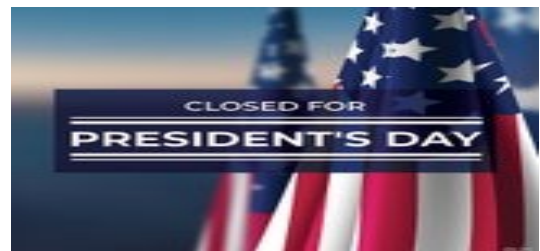

Allow time for prayer and reflection before Mass begins.

Choose appropriate clothing that reflects the sacredness of the occasion.



FASTING

fast from food and drink (except water) for one hour before Holy Communion.



SILENCE

Maintain silence in Church to allow for prayer and reflection.



TURN OFF DEVICES

Ensure all electronic devices are silenced or turned off to avoid distractions.

SPECIFIC POINTS



HOLY WATER

Bless your head with holy water upon entering and leaving the Church as a reminder of your Baptism.



TABERNACLE

Genuflect towards the tabernacle before sitting and after leaving your pew.



EUCCHARISTIC PRAYER

Maintain silence and reverence.

DURING MASS



PARTICIPATE

Engage actively by singing, responding, and praying with the community.



RESPECTFUL SILENCE

Refrain from talking, chewing gum, or engaging in any disruptive behavior.



RECEIVE HOLY COMMUNION WITH REVERENCE

If receiving, approach with a bow and consume the host immediately.



DO NOT LEAVE EARLY

Stay until the Mass concludes with a final blessing and recessional.

AFTER MASS



CONSIDER STAYING

For a few minutes of quiet prayer and thanksgiving after Mass.



RECESSIONAL

Remain in your pew until the priest, deacon and altar servers process out.

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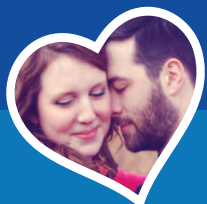
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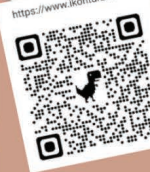
