Dear Families of Immaculate Heart of Mary,

In today's gospel, Jesus is angered that commercial activities are taking place in the Jerusalem temple. He tells the Jews that the temple will be destroyed and then "rebuilt" in three days. They misunderstand, thinking that He is speaking about the physical temple building. But, He is actually referring to Himself. He is preparing them, and us, for another Passover when the "temple" of His body will be sacrificed and then raised up. We, too, often misunderstand, missing the big picture. During this time of Lent, we can prepare ourselves for what is coming and so deepen our experience of Easter.

There is a lot going on here at IHM during this season of Lent. Deacon Ed continues the study of Romans on Thursday evenings at 7:00 PM. Stations of the Cross take place each Friday evening at 6:45 PM in the church. Mark your calendars for the parish Reconciliation Service on March 7 at 7:00 PM. On March 10 at 11:00 AM, Bishop Michael Barber will be here at IHM to celebrate Mass with our young people who are preparing for the sacrament of Confirmation.
