Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

"There arose no little dissension and debate." Did that happen at work this week? Most of us can recall run-ins with coworkers, even with the boss. Did it happen while socializing with friends? Go easy on politics, religion . . . even sports. At home? Even the most peaceful household experiences a little "give and take" now and then. So where was it that "there arose no little dissension and debate"? That tumultuous conflict occurred among our first Christian ancestors, disrupting the community life of the early church. But today's Acts of the Apostles shows how beautifully the Holy Spirit, promised by Jesus in today's Gospel, helped the church achieve a grace-filled resolution. What evolved was that "reconciled diversity," often encouraged by Pope Francis and even envisioned in today's Revelation passage; and a wondrous experience of Jesus' promised Gospel gift: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you."

"Peace be with you!" We say this at Mass every day. We turn to each other and say, "Peace be with you!" We may hug family members, hold our hand in a gesture, gentle nod of the head, to ask the Holy Spirit to come to others in our community.

Lo que evolucionó fue que la "diversidad reconciliada" frecuentemente animada por el Papa Francisco e incluso previstas en el pasaje de hoy del Apocalipsis y una experiencia maravillosa del don de Jesús prometido por Jesús: "La paz les dejo, mi paz les doy".

«¡La paz sea con vosotros!» Lo decimos en misa todos los días. Nos volvemos unos a otros y decimos: «¡La paz sea contigo!»». Podemos abrazar a los miembros de nuestra familia, hacer un gesto con la mano, inclinar suavemente la cabeza, para pedir al Espíritu Santo que venga a los demás en nuestra comunidad.

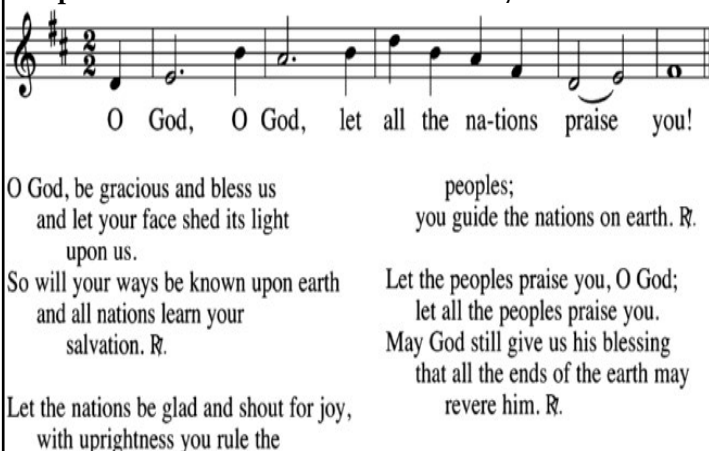

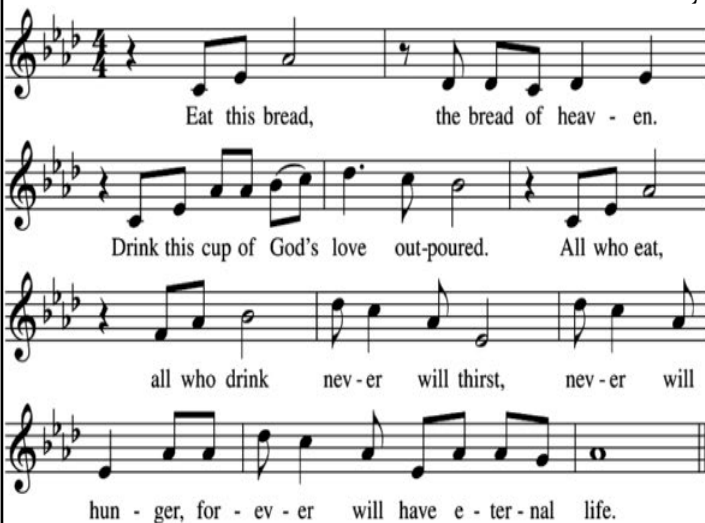

Pope St. Paul VI – May 29

All eyes have been on Rome lately with the death of Pope Francis and the conclave and election of Pope Leo XIV, the first American-born pope. This week, the Church celebrates a Pope who made some changes to the conclave process that were in effect in this latest conclave, St. Pope Paul VI.

Born Giovanni Montini on September 26, 1897, in Lombardy, Italy. He entered the seminary at 18 and was ordained to the priesthood when he was 22. He continued his studies after ordination, earning a doctorate in Canon Law. At the request of an Italian Cardinal, he entered the Secretariat of State, the diplomatic arm of the Roman Curia.

He entered the Roman Curia a few years later due to his organizational skills. He worked closely with Cardinal Pacelli, who became Pope Pius XII in 1939. He became his chief of staff shortly after. In 1954, Giovanni was appointed Archbishop of Milan. When his friend Angelo Roncalli became Pope St. John XXIII, he elevated Giovanni to Cardinal.

When Pope John XIII died during the Second Vatican Council, the Cardinals elected Giovanni Montini, who took the name Paul VI. Pope Paul VI continued the Council, which had adjourned without tangible results with the death of Pope John XXIII. He reopened the Council in September 1963, giving four key priorities: a better understanding of the Catholic Church, Church reforms, advancing the unity of Christians, and dialogue with the world.

In 1965, he established the Synod of Bishops as a permanent institution of the Church and an advisory body of the papacy. He implemented his reform of the Curia in stages. He reduced the bureaucracy, streamlined existing congregations, and brought many non-Italians to Curial positions. He asked all bishops to submit their resignations to the pontiff by their 75th birthday. He decreed that the Cardinals would relinquish their offices in the Curia upon their 80th birthday, and restricted the voting in future conclaves to Cardinals under 80. Pope Paul VI died on August 6, 1978.

Papa San Pablo VI - 29 de mayo

Todos los ojos han estado puestos en Roma últimamente con la muerte del Papa Francisco y el cónclave y elección del Papa León XIV, el primer Papa nacido en América. Esta semana, la Iglesia celebra a un Papa que hizo algunos cambios en el proceso del cónclave que entraron en vigor en este último cónclave, San Pablo VI.

Nació Giovanni Montini el 26 de septiembre de 1897 en Lombardía, Italia. Ingresó en el seminario a los 18 años y fue ordenado sacerdote a los 22 años. Continuó sus estudios tras la ordenación, doctorándose en Derecho Canónico. A petición de un cardenal italiano, ingresó en la Secretaría de Estado, el brazo diplomático de la Curia Romana.

Entró en la Curia Romana unos años más tarde debido a sus dotes organizativos. Trabajó estrechamente con el cardenal Pacelli, que se convirtió en el Papa Pío XII en 1939. Poco después se convirtió en su jefe de gabinete. En 1954, Giovanni fue nombrado arzobispo de Milán. Cuando su amigo Angelo Roncalli se convirtió en el Papa San Juan XXIII, elevó a Giovanni a Cardenal.

A la muerte de Juan XIII, durante el Concilio Vaticano II, los cardenales eligieron a Giovanni Montini, que tomó el nombre de Pablo VI. El Papa Pablo VI continuó el Concilio, que se había aplazado sin resultados tangibles con la muerte del Papa Juan XXIII. Reabrió el Concilio en septiembre de 1963, estableciendo cuatro prioridades clave: una mejor comprensión de la Iglesia católica, las reformas eclesásticas, el avance de la unidad de los cristianos y el diálogo con el mundo.

En 1965, instituyó el Sínodo de los Obispos como institución permanente de la Iglesia y órgano consultivo del papado. Llevó a cabo su reforma de la Curia por etapas. Redujo la burocracia, racionalizó las congregaciones existentes y llevó a muchos no italianos a puestos curiales. Pidió a todos los obispos que presentaran su renuncia al pontífice antes de cumplir los 75 años. Decretó que los cardenales renunciarían a sus cargos en la Curia al cumplir 80 años, y restringió la votación en futuros cónclaves a los cardenales menores de 80 años. El Papa Pablo VI murió el 6 de agosto de 1978.
