Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

"Until next week, keep your feet on the ground and keep reaching for the stars!" Not today's scriptural wisdom, but legendary DJ Casey Kasem's sage advice, heard across America for generations, *American Top 40's* challenging sign-off. Though Casey wasn't quoting scripture, today's Acts of the Apostles offers similar advice. As Jesus ascended, disciples "were looking intently at the sky." Wouldn't we prefer a soul-relaxing gaze into peaceful blue skies to a heart-breaking focus on this blood-stained earth?

But heavenly questioners asked Jesus' first disciples, "Why are you standing there looking at the sky?" Earth awaited their mission! While our hearts should "keep reaching for" heaven, we need to "keep our feet on the ground." Ascension's scriptures and the Jubilee of Mercy remind us: the Jesus we revere as "ascended into heaven" lives right here among us on earth, awaiting our recognition and loving service.

Yesterday, 118 teens from the second year Confirmation classes received the Sacrament of Confirmation by Bishop Michael Barber, S.J. Two years of classes, retreats, community service to IHM to prepare them to receive the Holy Spirit and grow in their faith and love of God. Many times, people associate this Sacrament with Graduation. Many of us wore gowns in years past when we were confirmed. But this is not a graduation or end of learning the faith. It is a beginning, a start to life as a full member of the Catholic Church and the continued deepening of Faith. Please keep them in your prayers.

Cuando Jesús ascendió, los discípulos "miraban fijamente el cielo". ¿No preferiríamos una mirada relajante del alma en un cielo azul tranquilo hasta un enfoque descorazonador en una tierra manchada de sangre?

Pero los interlocutores celestiales preguntaron a los primeros discípulos, ¿por qué están parados ahí mirando el cielo? ¡La tierra espera su misión! Mientras nuestros corazones deben "seguir buscando en el cielo", nosotros necesitamos "mantener nuestros pies en la tierra". Los pasajes de la Ascensión y el jubileo de la misericordia nos recuerdan, el Jesús que veneramos cuando "ascendió al cielo" vive aquí mismo en medio de nosotros en la tierra, esperando nuestro reconocimiento y servicio amoroso.

Ayer, 118 adolescentes de las clases de Confirmación de segundo año recibieron el Sacramento de la Confirmación por el Obispo Michael Barber, S.J. Dos años de clases, retiros, servicio comunitario a IHM para prepararlos a recibir el Espíritu Santo y crecer en su fe y amor a Dios. Muchas veces, la gente asocia este Sacramento con la Graduación. Muchos de nosotros usamos togas en años pasados cuando fuimos confirmados. Pero esto no es una graduación o el final del aprendizaje de la fe. Es un comienzo, un inicio a la vida como miembro pleno de la Iglesia Católica y la continua profundización de la Fe. Por favor, mantenedlos en vuestras oraciones.

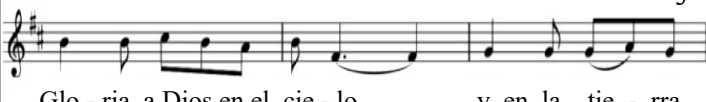

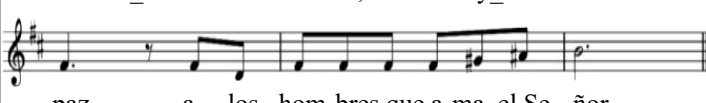

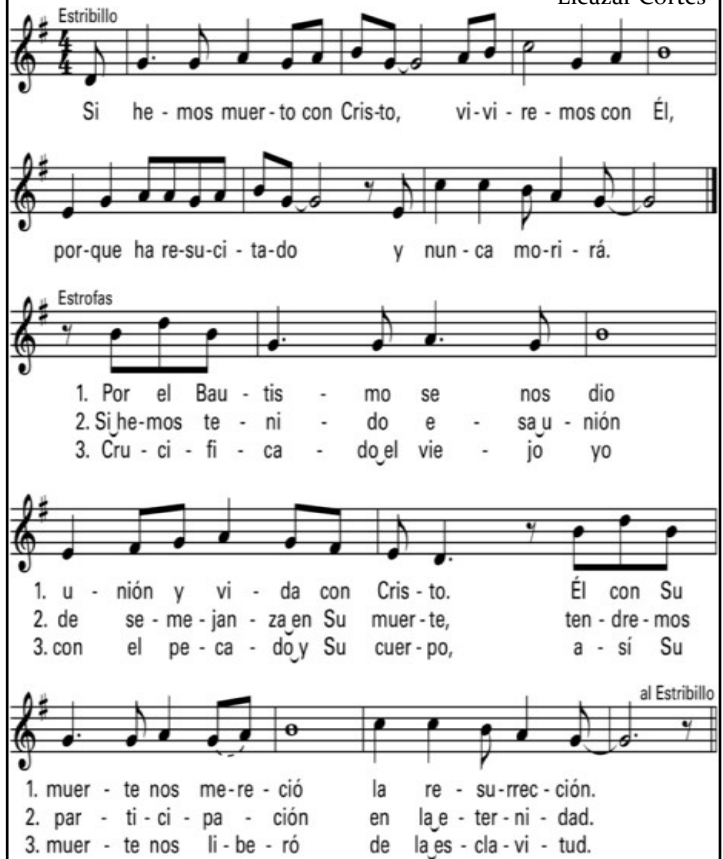

The Ascension of the Lord- June 1

June is the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus is celebrated on the Friday after Corpus Christi, which is celebrated on the second Sunday after Pentecost. The Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary is celebrated the day after the Sacred Heart of Jesus, this year on June 28.

This weekend at Mass, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. Next weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost, which marks the end of the Easter Season. The Sunday following Pentecost is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. As mentioned above, the Sunday after Trinity Sunday is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). As you can see, June is full of significant feasts in the liturgical calendar!

The Ascension of the Lord marks Jesus' ascension into heaven forty days after his resurrection. This puts the Ascension on a Thursday, this year on May 29. In most dioceses in the United States, including ours, the observance of the Ascension is transferred to the following Sunday, June 1.

The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* describes the Ascension in paragraph 659, "So then the Lord Jesus, after he had spoken to them, was taken up into heaven, and sat down at the right hand of God.' Christ's body was glorified at the moment of his Resurrection, as proved by the new and supernatural properties it subsequently and permanently enjoys. But during the forty days when he eats and drinks familiarly with his disciples and teaches them about the kingdom, his glory remains veiled under the appearance of ordinary humanity. Jesus' final apparition ends with the irreversible entry of his humanity into divine glory, symbolized by the cloud and by heaven, where he is seated from that time forward at God's right hand."

Junio es el mes del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús. La solemnidad del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús se celebra el viernes después del Corpus Christi, que se celebra el segundo domingo después de Pentecostés. La fiesta del Inmaculado Corazón de María se celebra al día siguiente del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús, este año el 28 de junio.

Este fin de semana celebramos en Misa la Solemnidad de la Ascensión del Señor. El próximo fin de semana celebramos la Solemnidad de Pentecostés, que marca el final del Tiempo Pascual. El domingo siguiente a Pentecostés es la Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad. Como ya hemos dicho, el domingo siguiente al de la Trinidad es la Solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo (Corpus Christi). Como puede ver, junio está lleno de fiestas significativas en el calendario litúrgico.

La Ascensión del Señor marca la subida de Jesús al cielo cuarenta días después de su resurrección. Esto sitúa la Ascensión en un jueves, este año el 29 de mayo. En la mayoría de las diócesis de Estados Unidos, incluida la nuestra, la celebración de la Ascensión se traslada al domingo siguiente, 1 de junio.

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica describe la Ascensión en el párrafo 659, «Así que el Señor Jesús, después de hablarles, fue elevado al cielo y se sentó a la diestra de Dios». El cuerpo de Cristo fue glorificado en el momento de su Resurrección, como lo prueban las propiedades nuevas y sobrenaturales de que goza posteriormente y de modo permanente. Pero durante los cuarenta días en que come y bebe familiarmente con sus discípulos y les enseña el Reino, su gloria permanece velada bajo la apariencia de la humanidad ordinaria. La última aparición de Jesús termina con la entrada irreversible de su humanidad en la gloria divina, simbolizada por la nube y por el cielo, donde está sentado desde entonces a la derecha de Dios».

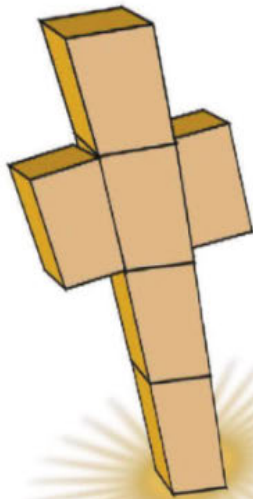

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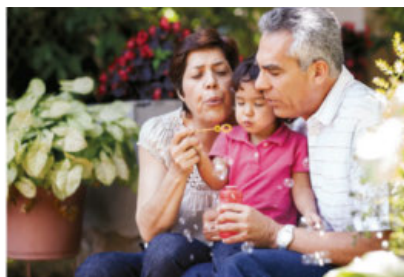
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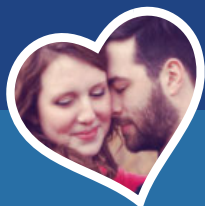
