Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

When Jesus saw the crowds, he was moved with compassion. The Greek word for compassion in this context suggests more than a fickle feeling or sentimental reaction. Rather, the compassion Matthew describes comes from the deepest pit of Jesus' being. And what was it about the crowds that moved Jesus so deeply? They were troubled and abandoned like sheep without a shepherd. But instead of simply continuing his own teaching and preaching and healing, Jesus summons his apostles to go out into the world and do his work. While it may seem that Jesus is simply delegating, he is making an important statement. We all have the responsibility to participate in the preaching, teaching and healing of Christ.

Like the first apostles, we are all called to be part of the mission. Similarly, like the first apostles, we must have faith. You can imagine that the apostles might have felt inadequate or unprepared for the task Jesus gave them. We might even feel the same intimidation or trepidation. But it is faith that moves us forward and faith that guides our way. We pray that we might have the faith to respond to God's calling in our lives today, not ignoring our fear or apprehensions but trusting that God will provide and care for us throughout the process.

Aunque pueda parecer que Jesús simplemente está delegando, está haciendo una declaración importante. Todos tenemos la responsabilidad de participar en la predicación, enseñanza y sanación de Cristo.

Como los primeros apóstoles, todos estamos llamados a formar parte de la misión. De manera similar, como los primeros apóstoles, debemos tener fe. Puedes imaginar que los apóstoles se sintieron insuficientes o poco preparados para la tarea que Jesús les asignó. Incluso podríamos sentir la misma intimidación o temor. Pero es la fe la que nos impulsa hacia adelante y la fe la que guía nuestro camino. Oremos para que tengamos la fe para responder al llamado de Dios en nuestras vidas hoy, no ignorando nuestro miedo o inquietud, sino confiando en que Dios proveerá y cuidará de nosotros durante todo el proceso.

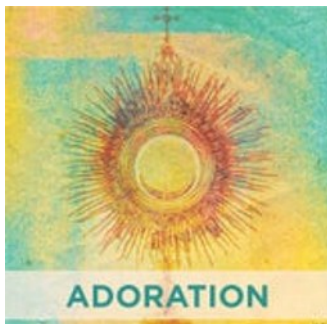

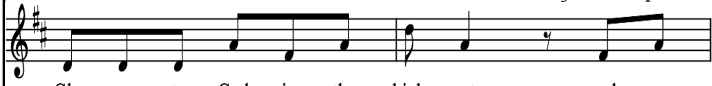

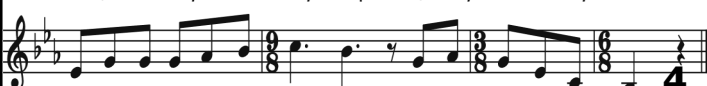

## Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

Ex 19:2-6a | Rom 5:6-11 | Mt 9:36-10:8

### **GROW AS A DISCIPLE** | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Our first reading from Exodus contains a promise: “If you hearken to my voice and keep my covenant, you shall be my special possession, dearer to me than all other people.” God promises to make Israel “a kingdom of priests, a holy nation,” if they keep the covenant. Reading the rest of the Old Testament, we know how this turns out: humanity never fully keeps our part of the covenant. And yet God is faithful, despite our unfaithfulness. In the Gospel, Jesus sends his disciples not to pagan territory or any Samaritan towns, but to “the lost sheep of the house of Israel,” revealing that God never abandons his chosen ones. Indeed, this is the same point Paul makes when he says, “But God proves his love for us in that while we were still sinners Christ died for us.” Our discipleship begins from a deep awareness of the relentless love with which God pursues us. Even when we stray from our baptismal covenant with him, he comes looking to save us and bring us back to himself.

### **GO** EVANGELIZE

#### PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Today’s Gospel ends with a powerful reminder to all evangelizers: “Without cost you have received; without cost you are to give.” Knowing the limitless mercy of God – how God has reconciled us to himself through Christ’s suffering and death, we are to imitate his generosity in bearing witness to the Gospel. Knowing the love which has saved us, our hearts are moved – as Jesus’ was at the sight of the crowd – to see that others come to know his love. Therefore, the generosity with which Jesus calls us to pour ourselves out for the sake of the Gospel is not an imposition from outside us, but a response to the love we have received that compels us from within to make him and his kingdom known.

### PRAY

St. Ignatius of Loyola wrote a prayer now known as the Prayer for Generosity. Pray this prayer each day this week, asking the Lord to increase your generosity as you labor in his “harvest,” sharing the Good News of his kingdom. *Eternal Word, only begotten Son of God, teach me true generosity. Teach me to serve you as you deserve. To give without counting the cost, to fight heedless of wounds, to labor without seeking rest, to sacrifice myself without thought of any reward save the knowledge that I have done your will. Amen.*
