Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

Today we celebrate the Holy Trinity, one of the most confounding mysteries of our faith. Through this mystery we experience our relationship to God: Creator, Savior, and Holy Spirit. This relationship is not easy to understand or to describe. It does not become clearer through analysis. Its complexity mirrors the complexity of all our relationships. We understand our relationships with our spouses, our children, our parents, and our friends only through daily give-and-take, annual rituals, and the life-changing moments we share. We understand our relationships only as we live them. The relationships we have with those we love, and who love us, sustain us through an uncertain and difficult life. This is the Holy Trinity.

What is striking about today's readings is that each is incomplete. What they do offer is a description of a moment in our relationship, a memory of a time and an event when our relationship made sense even though that sense may be beyond our ability to describe fully. Often that is all that our faith offers, that is, a memory of what is possible, what is promised, what has been given. A memory of eternity, of love beyond understanding is to be cherished and nurtured even if not fully understood. This is the Holy Trinity.

Next Saturday, June 21, we will celebrate the Immaculate Heart of Mary with our yearly Festival. Plan to attend and celebrate with all the parishioners a day of food, fun, games and entertainment.

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Between two people who love each other, speech often gives way to silence. But first, in order to nourish love, there must be a mutual exchange of words. Persons in love wish to share their most intimate secrets so that they might know and be known. In an act deserving of our endless wonder, God disclosed his most intimate secret to us: He is a communion of Persons — Father, Son, and Holy Spirit — who relate to each other in an eternal exchange of love. St. Thomas Aquinas insisted that the Trinity is not a reality we could have figured out on our own (in contrast to, for example, God's existence — which we can know simply by examining creation). God had to *reveal* his Trinitarian nature to us. While humanity was wandering further and further away from him over the millennia after the Fall, God was preparing us for the revelation of the Son and the Holy Spirit. This is what Jesus is announcing in today's Gospel: "Everything that the Father has is mine; for this reason I told you that [the Holy Spirit] will take from what is mine and declare it to you." To his bewildered disciples, Jesus is expressing God's intention to communicate his identity to us — an unmerited gift which he offers simply because he loves us.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

This is our inheritance as Christians: God has revealed himself to us out of love. Once we've assented to this truth, we can no longer dismiss the mystery of the Holy Trinity as "above my theological paygrade." One who loves is not bothered that the beloved always remains a mystery; instead, he or she is content to remain in wonder and seeks to enter more deeply into the exchange of love. For us, this means responding to God's gift of himself with reverence, gratitude, and obedience to his will. We approach him in prayer with the respectful but confident attitude of a child who knows itself to be deeply loved; we listen to him, express our thanksgiving for his gift, and seek to know his will for us.

PRAY

Be attentive to the ways God is revealing himself and his love for you in your daily life. Discover that *everything* is an expression of his care: answered prayers, a kind word given or received, the beauty of nature — even crosses which induce us to turn to him for help! Take a few minutes each day to thank God for his gifts.

Trinity Sunday

Welcome back to the liturgical cycle of Ordinary Time! This first Sunday following Pentecost, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. This solemnity was established as a feast throughout the universal Church by Pope John XXII in 1334. It is fitting that Trinity Sunday follows Pentecost, when we celebrate the descent of the Third Person of the Trinity, the Holy Spirit.

St. Athanasius, who was instrumental in his fight against the Arian Heresy in the fourth century, which denied Jesus' divinity, also answered challenges to the status of the Holy Spirit as God. After the Council of Nicaea, which was 1700 years ago, he wrote a letter to a bishop named Serapion. A portion of this letter is read in the Liturgy of the Hours Office of Readings for today:

"We acknowledge the Trinity, holy and perfect, to consist of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. In this Trinity, there is no intrusion of any alien element or anything from outside, nor is the Trinity a blend of creative and created being. It is a wholly creative and energizing reality, self-consistent and undivided in its active power, for the Father makes all things through the Word and in the Holy Spirit, and in this way, the unity of the holy Trinity is preserved. Accordingly, in the Church, one God is preached, and God who is *above all things and through all things and in all things*. God is *above all things* as Father, for he is principle and source; he is *through all things* through the Word; and he is *in all things* in the Holy Spirit."

St. Athanasius demonstrates how God is a Trinity, and all Persons of the Trinity are God. Today, among Christians, there is no fighting over the Trinity as there was 1700 years ago. The Trinity, however, is a stumbling block for non-Christians.

Most Holy Trinity, have mercy on us! Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us!

Domingo de la Trinidad

¡Bienvenidos de nuevo al ciclo litúrgico del Tiempo Ordinario! Este primer domingo después de Pentecostés, la Iglesia celebra la Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad. Esta solemnidad fue establecida como fiesta en toda la Iglesia universal por el Papa Juan XXII en 1334. Es apropiado que el Domingo de la Trinidad siga a Pentecostés, cuando celebramos el descenso de la Tercera Persona de la Trinidad, el Espíritu Santo.

San Atanasio, que fue decisivo en su lucha contra la herejía arriana en el siglo IV, que negaba la divinidad de Jesús, también respondió a los desafíos a la condición del Espíritu Santo como Dios. Después del Concilio de Nicea, que tuvo lugar hace 1700 años, escribió una carta a un obispo llamado Serapión. Una parte de esta carta se lee en el Oficio de Lecturas de la Liturgia de las Horas de hoy:

"Reconocemos que la Trinidad, santa y perfecta, está formada por el Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo. En esta Trinidad, no hay intrusión de ningún elemento extraño o algo de fuera, ni es la Trinidad una mezcla de ser creativo y creado. Es una realidad totalmente creadora y dinamizadora, autoconsistente e indivisa en su poder activo, porque el Padre hace todas las cosas por medio del Verbo y en el Espíritu Santo, y de este modo se conserva la unidad de la Santísima Trinidad. Por consiguiente, en la Iglesia se predica un solo Dios, que está sobre todas las cosas y por todas las cosas y en todas las cosas. Dios está *sobre todas las cosas como Padre*, pues es principio y fuente; está a través de todas las cosas por medio del Verbo; y *está en todas las cosas en el Espíritu Santo*".

San Atanasio demuestra cómo Dios es una Trinidad, y todas las Personas de la Trinidad son Dios. Hoy en día, entre los cristianos, no hay peleas sobre la Trinidad como hace 1700 años. La Trinidad, sin embargo, es un escollo para los no cristianos.
