Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

Following God is difficult. In the first reading Jeremiah reflects on the judgement of others upon his prophecy. Jesus gives the apostles encouragement for their mission, knowing they will face hardships. Paul reminds us of our own complicity in sin, our failure to follow God's commandments. However, despite this difficulty and the obstacles we face, the grace of God can sustain us as we try to share the gospel.

Even though most Christians in the developed world do not face the same persecution experienced by the early church, there are still many cultural challenges that make the Christian life difficult—consumerism, secularism, nationalism and individualism, to name a few. While these bigger trends can make our own call seem impossible, thinking locally and personally can help this task feel more manageable. Each of us is called to bring the gospel into our own relationships in both words and actions, trusting in God's support as we witness to his love for us.

Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us.

Cada uno de nosotros está llamado a llevar el evangelio a nuestras propias relaciones, tanto en palabras como en acciones, confiando en el apoyo de Dios mientras damos testimonio de su amor por nosotros.

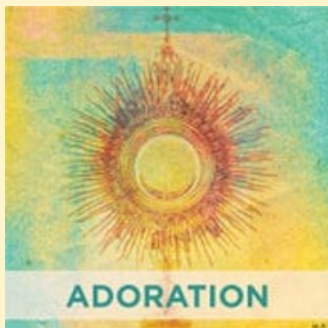

Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jer 20:10-13 | Rom 5:12-15 | Mt 10:26-33

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Beginning with the original sin of Adam and Eve, humanity has lived in a way that has separated us from God's perfect love. Despite the many ways we have tried to draw near to God, it is impossible for us to repair this relationship on our own. The ways we turn away from God, therefore, require an outpouring of mercy and forgiveness, which our loving Father is eager to offer. When speaking of the grace that defeated the power of death, St. Paul reminds us in his Letter to the Romans that "the gift is not like the transgression." God's love for us is overflowing, and his desire to be in relationship with us is manifest in his giving his life for our salvation. Christ longs to heal and free us from the hold of sin in our lives, and we can experience this grace when we encounter Christ as the Divine Physician in the sacrament of reconciliation.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

In witness to the promise of eternal life and joy, we are called to live in a countercultural way, adhering to the words of the Gospel and the Tradition of the Church. We know this is not always easy. Yet, the Lord – through the prophet Jeremiah – reassures us that God is with us, and that he will be our "mighty champion." In the Gospel passage, Jesus speaks to the Apostles as they prepare to travel and preach the Good News. He warns them they will experience persecution, but he also reminds them that God is abundantly generous in his care for them. God cares for us in the same way as we continue our work of evangelization. He values us as precious children, and he promises that we will not be left alone in whatever challenges we may encounter while proclaiming the truth of his love.

PRAY

It can be difficult to rest in the promise of a love that exceeds our human faults and failings. It may seem impossible to be fully known and yet still exceedingly loved. The gift God offers us of being known, loved, and forgiven demonstrates a level of goodness that far exceeds any wrong we may have done. In your prayer this week, ask God for the grace to trust in this abundance of love that he desires to give to you.
