

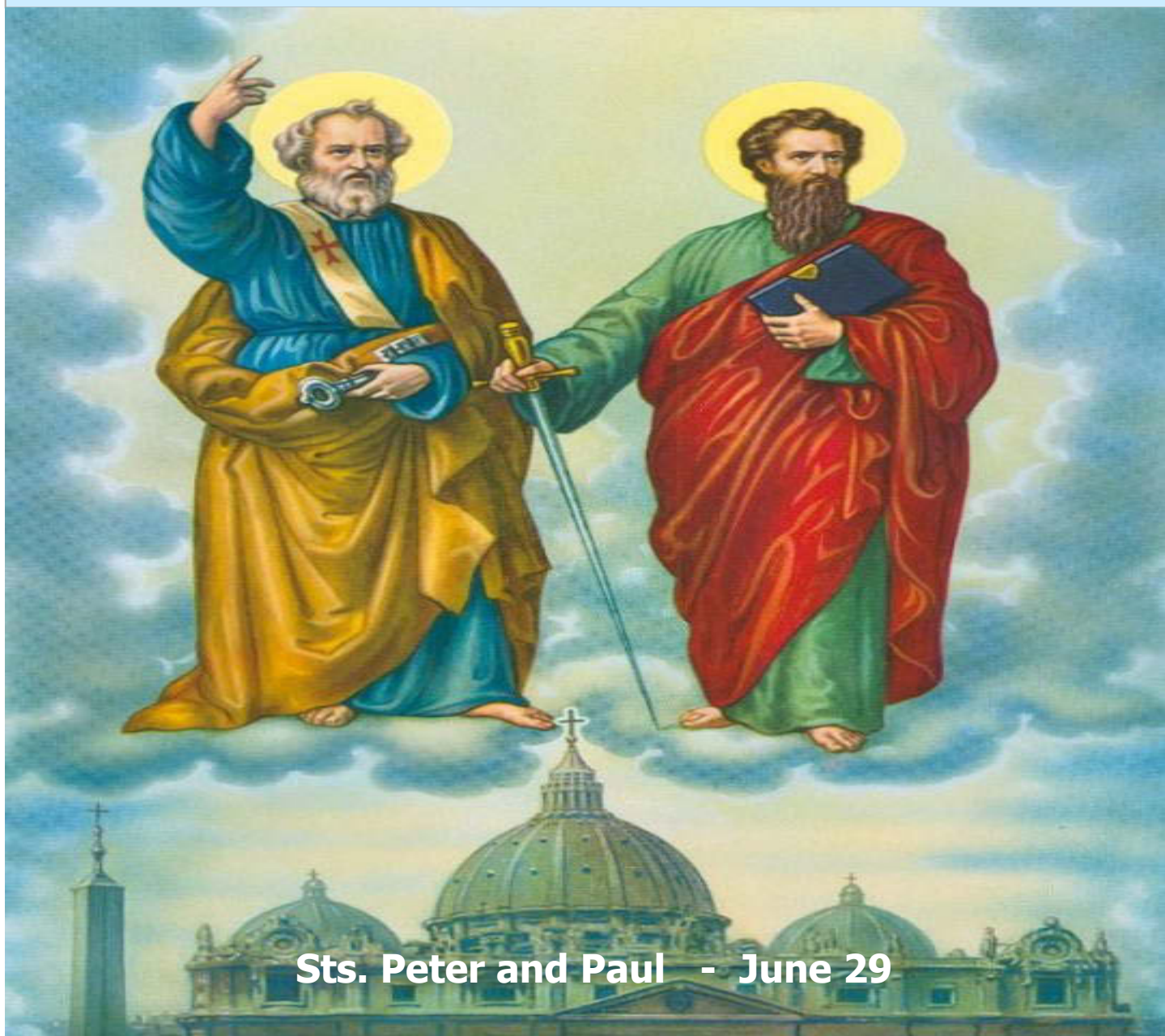

Dear families of the Immaculate heart of Mary,

In today's first reading, God tells the prophet Elijah to prepare Elisha to succeed him. Succeeding Elijah will be no easy task; he has spent his life facing threats from the kings he has confronted about their infidelity to the God of Israel. The psalm illustrates the emotional and spiritual distress that the prophets' steadfast faithfulness to God brought them.

Paul's description of the Christian's freedom from the law as opposed to "the desire of the flesh" puts this struggle at the very heart of Christian identity. The reading from Luke's Gospel recounts Jesus' decision to journey toward Jerusalem, where he knows he will meet his earthly fate. Following Jesus—like succeeding Elijah as prophet—will now become more difficult. Unlike his calls to the first disciples, Jesus encounters those who are not ready or are not strong enough to journey with him.

In today's world we may find that we are not ready or strong enough. With all that is happening in the world we need to continue to depend on God to guide us and follow Christ's footsteps, so we stay on the right path. That means coming to mass and receiving communion which is our nourishment for our faith. Also, frequent reconciliation gives us the grace we need.

Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us.

Queridas familias del Inmaculado Corazón de María,

En la primera lectura de hoy, Dios le dice al profeta Elías que prepare a Eliseo para que sea su sucesor. Ser sucesor de Elías no será una tarea fácil, él ha pasado su vida enfrentado las amenazas de los reyes a los que ha confrontado por sus infidelidades al Dios de Israel. El salmo ilustra la angustia emocional y espiritual que la firme fidelidad de los profetas a Dios les produjo.

La descripción de Pablo de la libertad del cristiano frente a la ley en contraposición al "deseo de la carne" pone esta lucha en el corazón mismo de la identidad cristiana. La lectura del Evangelio de Lucas relata la decisión de Jesús de viajar a Jerusalén, donde él sabe que encontrará su destino terrenal. Seguir a Jesús, así como suceder a Elías como profeta, será menos fácil. A diferencia de sus llamadas a los primeros discípulos, Jesús se encuentra con aquellos que no están preparados o no son lo suficientemente fuertes para viajar con él.

En el mundo actual podemos encontrarnos con que no estamos preparados o no somos lo suficientemente fuertes. Con todo lo que está sucediendo en el mundo tenemos que seguir dependiendo de Dios para que nos guíe y seguir los pasos de Cristo, para que nos mantengamos en el camino correcto. Eso significa venir a misa y recibir la comunión, que es el alimento de nuestra fe. Además, la reconciliación frecuente nos da la gracia que necesitamos.

Members of our family joke that saying goodbye after a family gathering needs to begin about an hour before we plan to leave. Goodbyes mean hugs for every family member, and there are many of us! We are aware of how precious our loved ones are to us, and so Jesus' response to the person who asks if he can first say farewell to his family may seem perplexing to us. But in this reading, Luke presents Jesus as "resolutely" headed to Jerusalem because "the days for Jesus' being taken up were fulfilled." Jesus is ready to complete the mission he came for and anyone who wants to follow him can't be distracted by indecision. His matter-of-fact answers are directed at newcomers who seem to hesitate when he invites them to follow him. He wants his disciples to know that being a disciple will have an impact on personal comfort, and that everything one does – for family, loved ones, or whomever – must flow from this discipleship *first*. It is not about ignoring other responsibilities, but carrying them out in light of who we are and whom we follow. Jesus calls us to make our relationship with him our highest priority. Doing so will bring life to all the relationships we value as we grow to live and love like him.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

How do we commit to answering God's call without hesitation? Like the first Apostles, the prosperous farmer Elisha in today's first reading willingly responded to the call from Elijah. But he didn't just leave everything and go: He first burned his plow as fuel in order to cook the oxen and leave it for his people to eat. In following the Lord, his first act was to ensure that those for whom he was responsible were not left without. Answering God's call is not often easy. But like Elisha and the Apostles, we are called to listen and respond to the ways God calls us and to trust in his Spirit to guide us. As Paul tells the Galatians, we are to "live by the Spirit." By trusting in the power of the Holy Spirit and turning to him for strength and guidance, we can be Christ's presence wherever he leads us – and doing whatever it entails.

INVITE Ask the Holy Spirit to help you discern who needs the gift of your presence in their life right now. Schedule time with this person, just listening, affirming their gifts, and assuring them of your belief in them and God's love for them.

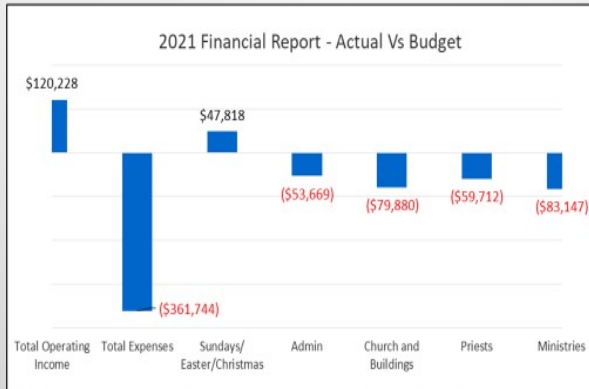
Finance Committee Goals

- Our 2022 operating income is forecast to meet our daily needs, keep current on facilities maintenance, and fund projects that will reduce future costs

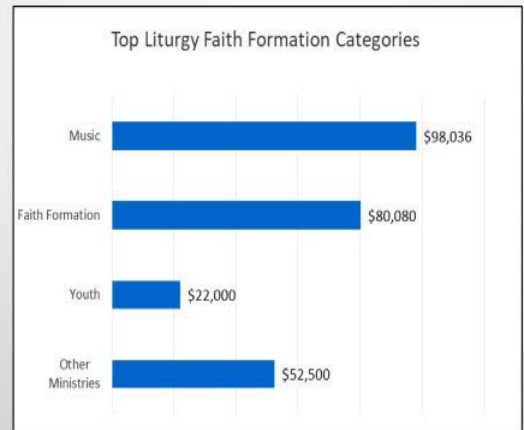
2021 Review



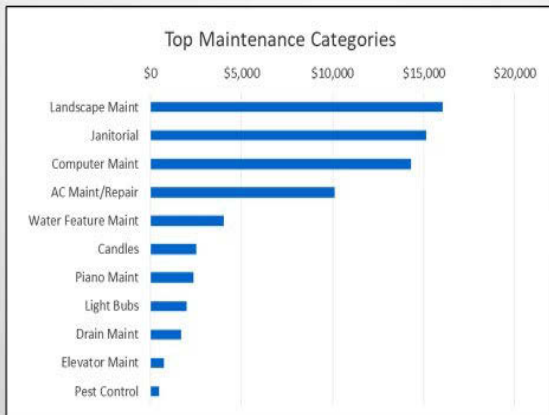
Income exceeded budget, with expenses down across almost all categories. Due to Covid, our staff sacrificed pay, while still keeping the Parish running.
