The Pastor's Page/Página del Pastor

Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

Today is a solemnity because of the significance of both Peter and Paul, two of the most important figures in the early church. Who could have guessed that a Galilean fisherman and a Pharisee from Tarsus could change the course of world history? Together, these great saints root the church firmly in the city of Rome—both ministered and were killed there—and are inseparable as leaders in the early Church. They are also demonstrable proof that God qualifies the called rather than the other way around.

Peter is so emboldened to proclaim Christ crucified and risen such that he is ultimately martyred for his faith—according to tradition, upside down, feeling unworthy to be killed in the same manner as Jesus. Peter lived and died in response to his claim in today's gospel—that Jesus is the Son of God.

When we first meet Saul of Tarsus, he is depicted as "trying to destroy the church" (Acts 8:3) and is forcibly sending Christians to imprisonment. In a drastic transformation, Saul is knocked off his horse by the surprise of encountering the risen Christ on the road to Damascus. In this moment Paul recognizes who Jesus is, and this realization upends his whole life. Like Peter, Paul is also martyred for his faith witnessing in death to the same Christ he had witnessed to in his life and writings.

Are we willing to let an encounter with Jesus Christ transform our own lives, regardless of where that leads us?

Queridas familias del Inmaculado Corazón de María,

Hoy es un día solemne por la importancia tanto de Pedro como de Pablo, dos de las figuras más importantes de la Iglesia primitiva. ¿Quién podía imaginar que un pescador galileo y un fariseo de Tarso cambiarían el curso de la historia del mundo? Juntos, estos grandes santos arraigan la Iglesia firmemente en la ciudad de Roma —ambos ministeraron y fueron asesinados allí— y son inseparables como líderes de la Iglesia primitiva. También son pruebas demostrables que Dios califica a los llamados y no al revés.

Pedro se envalentona tanto al proclamar a Cristo crucificado y resucitado que al final es martirizado por su fe—según la tradición, de cabeza, sintiéndose indigno de ser asesinado de la misma manera que Jesús. Pedro vivió y murió en respuesta a su afirmación en el evangelio de hoy: que Jesús es el Hijo de Dios.

Cuando conocemos por primera vez a Saulo de Tarso, se le describe «tratando de destruir la iglesia» (Hechos 8:3) y enviando por la fuerza a cristianos a la cárcel. En una drástica transformación, Saulo es derribado del caballo por la sorpresa de encontrarse con Cristo resucitado en el camino de Damasco. En ese momento, Pablo reconoce quién es Jesús, y esta comprensión trastorna toda su vida. Como Pedro, Pablo también es martirizado por su fe, dando testimonio en la muerte del mismo Cristo del que había dado testimonio en su vida y en sus escritos.

¿Estamos dispuestos a dejar que un encuentro con Jesucristo transforme nuestras propias vidas, independientemente de adónde nos lleve?





Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles

Acts 12:1-11 | 2 Tim 4:6-8, 17-18 | Mt 16:13-19

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Too often, we conceive of our earthly pilgrimage as a convoluted maze we must travel by ourselves. Consequently, many of us either ignore the question altogether or become overwhelmed by how ill-equipped we are for the task. But in today's Gospel, Jesus indicates that confusion was never part of his plan. Responding to Peter's profession of faith, Jesus says, "You are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church." From the mouth of Eternal Wisdom comes words which establish a Church on Peter's God-given faith. Already a leader among the disciples, Peter now receives his vocation to be the foundation of unity among the Apostles. Their successors, the bishops, would be recognizable by their union with Peter's successors, the popes. Over time, the Church's understanding of Peter's authority would mature and deepen. From the beginning, however, Peter's role as shepherd meant that navigating the path to heaven was not something we were to do in isolation. We aren't asked to decipher the meaning of the Scriptures ourselves or to untangle centuries of theological speculation in order to follow Jesus. God, who knows we cannot make the journey alone, has given us a visible Church to be our guide.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Jesus established the Church so that we would have a sure and safe means of transit on our earthly pilgrimage. Convinced though we may be of this truth, we nevertheless have to contend with the storms that buffet her from within and without. Yet we can rest in Jesus' assurance to Peter: "the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it." The Church has survived for millennia as empires have risen and fallen around her. Even in her darkest hours, Christ has continued to speak through her and, by his sacraments, to touch us intimately with his love.

PRAY

Today's first reading, which takes place when Peter is in prison, contains an interesting detail: "Prayer by the Church was fervently being made to God on [Peter's] behalf." As members of Christ's Church on earth, we are not meant to be passive players. This week, pray for Peter — that is, for his successor, the pope — that he may fulfill his lofty and difficult vocation to lead the world to Christ.

Jubilee of Priests

Each month, we examine an aspect of the Jubilee 2025 Pilgrims of Hope. There are designated Jubilee Days throughout 2025. Previously, we highlighted the Jubilee of Confraternities. This month, we will examine the Jubilee of Priests, which took place from June 25 to 27.

In the Catholic Church, priests are ordained men who share in the ministry of Christ through their preaching and administration of the sacraments in their diocese or religious institute. The office of the priesthood, instituted by Christ and passed down through the apostles, conforms men to "Christ the Priest in such a way that they can act in the person of Christ the Head" (*Presbyterorum Ordinis*)

Without priests, there is no Sacrament of Confession or Anointing of the Sick. Without priests, there is no Mass, no Eucharist. Priests play a vital role in our salvation. Our parish is fortunate to have three priests. Fr. Quang was ordained to the priesthood on May 24, 1991. Fr. Houng and Fr. Candelario were ordained together on May 22, 2021. Our Diocese, the Diocese of Oakland, covers Alameda and Contra Costa counties. There are 84 parishes in the diocese and around 115 priests. On May 24, Fr. Alvaro Santamaría was ordained to the priesthood by Bishop Michael Barber. We thank God for these men and all priests for their 'yes' to God.

Our diocese needs more priests. We live in a place where the secular culture holds sway. Young men who are willing to give their lives to serve God and his church are difficult to find here. We should be fasting and praying for vocations to the priesthood in our diocese. For holy men who are willing to turn away from the empty promises of wealth, pleasure, honor, and power, which the culture values. Men who are eager to wholeheartedly give their lives to Christ for the salvation of souls. Men who will promise to be celibate, to preach the truth, and to obey the bishop.

Sin sacerdotes, no hay Sacramento de la Confesión ni Unción de los Enfermos. Sin sacerdotes, no hay Misa ni Eucaristía. Los sacerdotes desempeñan un papel vital en nuestra salvación. Nuestra parroquia tiene la suerte de contar con tres sacerdotes. El P. Quang quien fue ordenado sacerdote el 24 de mayo de 1991. El P. Houng y el P. Candelario fueron ordenados juntos el 22 de mayo de 2021. Nuestra diócesis, la Diócesis de Oakland, abarca los condados de Alameda y Contra Costa. Hay 84 parroquias en la diócesis y alrededor de 115 sacerdotes. El 24 de mayo, el P. Álvaro Santamaría fue ordenado sacerdote por el Obispo Michael Barber. Damos gracias a Dios por estos hombres y por todos los sacerdotes por su «sí» a Dios.

Nuestra diócesis necesita más sacerdotes. Vivimos en un lugar donde impera la cultura secular. Aquí es difícil encontrar jóvenes dispuestos a dar su vida para servir a Dios y a su Iglesia. 


