Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

In today's gospel, Jesus speaks to the importance of vulnerability in a life of faith. From the Latin word "to wound," vulnerability sometime—and rightly so—has a pejorative connotation. This is where we must make an important distinction. Jesus is not proposing that we seek out pain or hurt, nor is he suggesting we put ourselves in a dangerous situation. Rather, the vulnerability Jesus speaks of is rooted in humility and self-knowledge. It is when we are humble, self-aware, and cognizant of our needs that we are most open to Jesus because we have nothing to lose but everything to gain.

Jesus also reminds us that we are never alone. While we will most certainly face difficulties, we are not left to fend for ourselves. The first reading from Zechariah reminds us that God comes to us and is present with us, banishing the warrior's bow and proclaiming peace to the nations. When we feel like we are alone and cannot carry our burdens, let us remember that God is indeed with us through it all. We are weighed down by social fatigue and difficult relationships and lack of finance or other resources. We are weighed down by loneliness and fear and desperation. Sometimes we are just plain tired. Let us remember, especially in these times, that God is meek and humble of heart. It is in God alone that we will find rest.

Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us.

En el evangelio actual, Jesús habla de la importancia de la vulnerabilidad en una vida de fe. De la palabra latina "herir", vulnerabilidad a veces —y con razón— tiene una connotación peyorativa. Aquí es donde debemos hacer una distinción importante. Jesús no propone que busquemos el dolor o el sufrimiento, ni sugiere que nos pongamos en una situación peligrosa. Más bien, la vulnerabilidad de la que habla Jesús está arraigada en la humildad y el autoconocimiento. Es cuando somos humildes, conscientes de nosotros mismos y conscientes de nuestras necesidades cuando estamos más abiertos a Jesús porque no tenemos nada que perder pero todo que ganar.

Jesús también nos recuerda que nunca estamos solos. Aunque sin duda nos enfrentaremos a dificultades, no nos dejan valernos por nuestra cuenta. La primera lectura de Zacarías nos recuerda que Dios viene a nosotros y está presente con nosotros, desterrando el arco del guerrero y proclamando la paz a las naciones. Cuando sentimos que estamos solos y no podemos cargar con nuestras cargas, recordemos que Dios está realmente con nosotros en todo momento. Estamos agobiados por la fatiga social, las relaciones difíciles y la falta de recursos económicos u otros. Estamos agobiados por la soledad, el miedo y la desesperación. A veces simplemente estamos cansados. Recordemos, especialmente en estos tiempos, que Dios es dócil y humilde de corazón. Es solo en Dios donde encontraremos descanso.

On behalf of all the members of the Finance Council we would like to thank each of you for your support and dedication to our Parish.

2025 was another busy year with many projects completed and some still underway. Just as with our own homes, our church is in constant need of maintenance and upgrading as well as needing to have items replaced.

Some of the things that have been replaced and repaired are not always visible but are needed, such as upgrading the watering system and replacing lighting on the exterior walls and in the church. We replaced the hot water heater for the kitchen and outside bathrooms. The speakers in the chapel were repaired, bird abatement on the roof of the church was needed to protect the life of the roof, tree trimming and gutter cleaning were also completed.

As you can see from the attached graph, 19% of our annual income is spent on just our buildings and maintenance.

Finance Council is also being proactive in making sure that we budget for large expenditures that we know will be coming in the next few years such as replacing air conditioning units, repaving of the parking lots and painting.

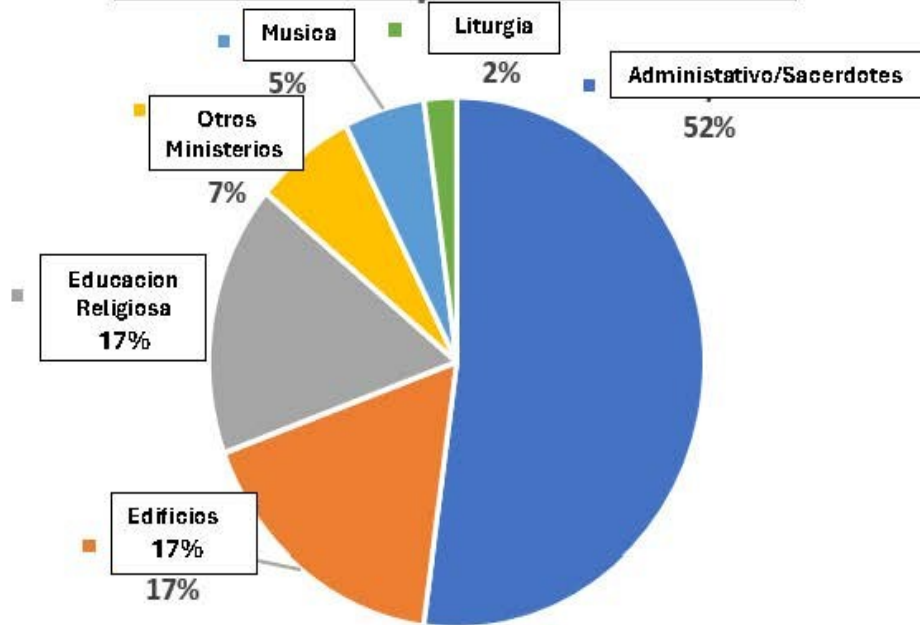
We had a comprehensive 5-year plan prepared by a Diocese approved company to give us a better idea of how much to set aside each year for these items. Again, referring to the graph you will see that we came in over budget, and a part of these funds were carried over and are to be allocated to reserves, as suggested by the 5-year plan. By doing this we can be sure to have funds available for unexpected expenses and continue to cover all items needed to support the daily/monthly requirements of running the parish.

We are blessed to have one of the best religious education programs in the area and the directors of these programs work hard to keep the curriculum up to date and current. This does require funds over and above tuition, and the Finance Council makes adequate funding in the budget to allow for these expenditures.

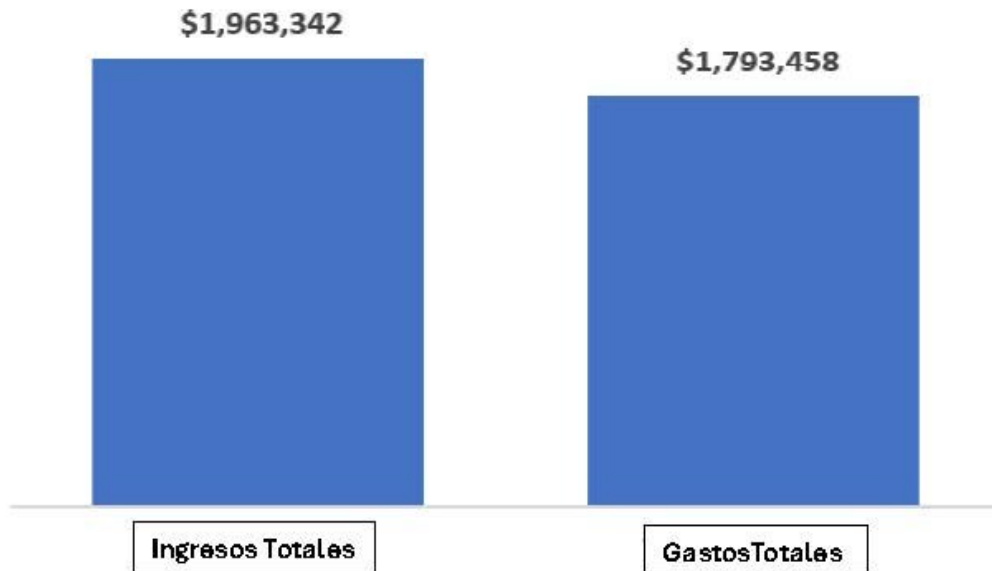

Informe Anual de la Parroquia Enero - Diciembre de 2025

Estimados feligreses de la parroquia del Inmaculado Corazón de María,

En nombre de todos los miembros del Consejo de Finanzas, queremos darles las gracias a cada uno de ustedes por vuestro apoyo y dedicación a nuestra parroquia.

El año 2025 ha sido otro año muy ajetreado, en el que se han completado muchos proyectos y algunos siguen en marcha. Al igual que ocurre con nuestros propios hogares, nuestra iglesia necesita constantemente mantenimiento y mejoras, además de la sustitución de algunos elementos.

Algunas de las cosas que se han sustituido y reparado no siempre son visibles, pero son necesarias, como la mejora del sistema de riego y la sustitución de la iluminación en las paredes exteriores y en el interior de la iglesia. Hemos sustituido el calentador de agua de la cocina y de los baños exteriores. Se repararon los altavoces de la capilla; fue necesario instalar medidas para ahuyentar a las aves en el tejado de la iglesia con el fin de proteger su vida útil; y también se completaron la poda de árboles y la limpieza de canalones.

Como se puede observar en el gráfico adjunto, el 19 % de nuestros ingresos anuales se destinan únicamente a nuestros edificios y a su mantenimiento.

El Consejo de Finanzas también está actuando de forma proactiva para garantizar que se prevean en el presupuesto los grandes gastos que sabemos que se producirán en los próximos años, como la sustitución de las unidades de aire acondicionado, la repavimentación de los estacionamientos y el pintado de las instalaciones.

Contamos con un plan de 5-años exhaustivo elaborado por una empresa autorizada por la Diócesis para hacernos una idea más clara de cuánto debemos destinar cada año a estos conceptos. De nuevo, consulten el gráfico, verán que nos hemos excedido del presupuesto, y que una parte de estos fondos se han transferido y se destinarán a las reservas, tal y como sugiere el plan de 5-años. De este modo, nos aseguramos de disponer de fondos para gastos imprevistos y de seguir cubriendo todos los gastos necesarios para satisfacer las necesidades diarias y mensuales del funcionamiento de la parroquia.

Tenemos la suerte de contar con uno de los mejores programas de educación religiosa de la zona, y los directores de estos programas trabajan duro para mantener el plan de estudios actualizado y al día. Esto requiere fondos adicionales a la matrícula, y el Consejo de Finanzas destina la financiación adecuada en el presupuesto para cubrir estos gastos.

El Inmaculado Corazón de María es una parroquia próspera y bien gestionada gracias a nuestro dedicado clero y personal, pero no podría llevar a cabo ninguna de las actividades mencionadas anteriormente sin vuestro generoso y continuo apoyo.

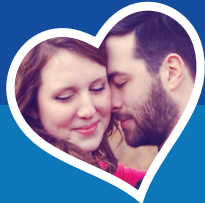

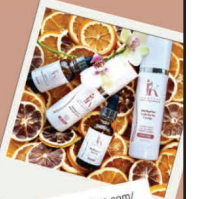
