

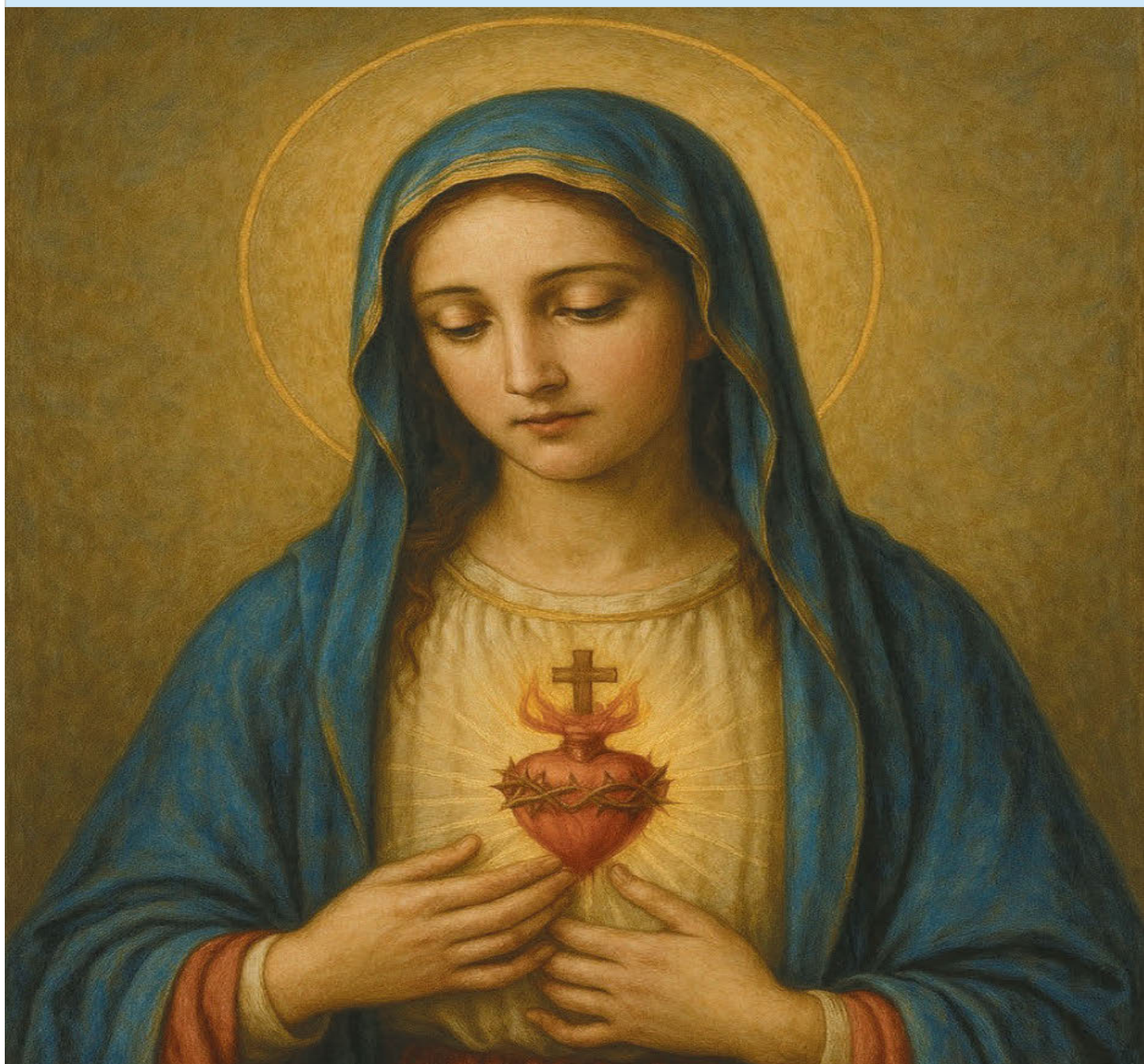

Dear Families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

Today's readings celebrate God's providence. No matter how wonderful (or heartbreaking) our relationships are, God always provides for us. No one cares for us the way God does.

Isaiah delights us with a deeply intimate image of God caring for us "as a mother comforts her child." The prophet describes us not as the usual "children of God," but as "babies." We should not resist this image but rejoice in it. Trusting in God's care, we can all let down our guard and rest like infants in the lap of our mother.

Saint Paul's trust in God allows him to be at peace like this. He boldly declares that no one can "make troubles" for him, because he has given himself completely to Jesus. And when Jesus sends his disciples out to preach and heal, he challenges them not to provide for themselves, but to let faith be their guide.

Do we have enough faith that God, our father, will provide for us? That He is always with us whether we are happy, sad, in sorrow, or in joy and even when we turn away? He never leaves us and if we turn away, all he wants is for us to ask for forgiveness.

Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us.

¿Tenemos suficiente fe en que Dios, nuestro Padre, proveerá para nosotros? Que siempre estará con nosotros si estamos alegres, tristes, en pena o en gozo e incluso cuando nos alejamos. Él nunca nos abandona y, si nos alejamos, lo único que quiere es que le pidamos perdón.

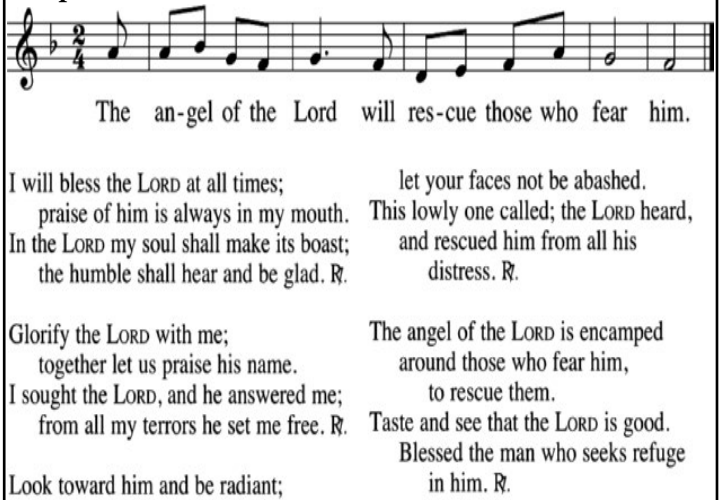

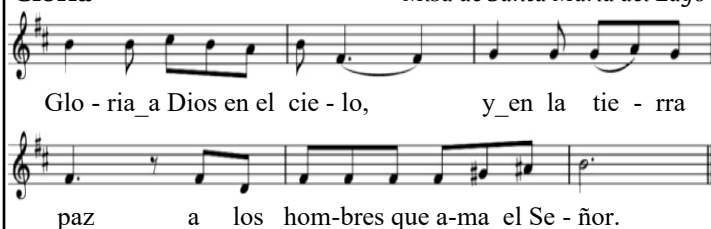

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Our calling as disciples of Christ is to evangelize. To be honest, it's something many of us aren't entirely comfortable with. Anyone who has ever felt ill-equipped to share the faith with family or friends should be reassured by today's Gospel. Jesus' early followers probably felt unprepared to share the news that the kingdom of God was at hand – and they received their marching orders from Jesus himself! When Jesus sent the seventy-two out to proclaim his coming, he knew they would feel insecure. He sent them without money, sandals, or even a sack for travel, and told them they would be lambs among wolves. How nervous they must have been given that ominous warning! Still, they believed they would have what they needed. Sure enough, their work was successful. They rejoiced because they could cast out demons in his name – something they never imagined was possible. They turned hearts to Christ because they trusted and obeyed him.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

When it comes to sharing our faith with the people God puts in our lives, we're asked to do the same as the seventy-two: Obey Jesus' command to go out and proclaim his kingdom and trust we will have what we need. It isn't necessary to rehearse our testimony. We don't need to memorize the Scriptures or cite chapter and verse. An advanced degree in theology isn't required. What is needed? Ears for listening and the patience to act. Listen closely for the person who says they're afraid or alone, confused or hurting. Listen with compassion to the person who feels abandoned by God. Listen with an open heart to the person who shares doubts or disappointments. Wait for an opening in the conversation to remind him or her that God loves them through every struggle. And share your faith through the power of prayer.

PRAY

This week, find that someone in your life who may be hurting for whatever reason. Tell them you will pray *for* them and offer to pray *with* them. Prayer and compassion are our marching orders, and we can follow them by trusting Jesus is right there with us when we need him.

St. Benedict of Nursia – July 11

This week, on July 11, the Church celebrates a saint known for several instrumental reasons. He is often credited with saving Western Christian culture after the fall of the Roman Empire. He is also known as the Father of Monasticism. Others may be familiar with him because of his medal. He is St. Benedict of Nursia.

While his name is often recognized by many for some of the reasons mentioned, relatively little concrete biographical information is known about him. He was born around the year 480, the son of a Roman nobleman of Nursia, in central Italy. He was sent to Rome for studies, but was disappointed by the moral corruption that was rampant in the city just a few years after the fall of the Empire. He retreated from Rome and stayed in a cave. He met a monk named Romanus of Subiaco near there and became a hermit. In his solitude, he matured and grew closer to God.

He was lured out of the cave by nearby monks whose abbot had died. Benedict became their abbot. The other monks were not pleased with the discipline Benedict tried to impose and twice attempted to poison him. He left that monastery and went on to found twelve new monasteries, ending with the great Monte Cassino.

Benedict wrote what is known as *The Rule of St. Benedict* for monks living under the authority of an abbot. The monasteries he founded followed this way of life. *The Rule* presupposes the autonomy of each community; therefore, Benedict was not out to form a new religious order, but these monasteries evolved into one.

St. John Henry Newman writes about the nature of renewal and reform influenced by the Benedictine monasticism of old. "Silent men were observed about the country digging, clearing, and building. Others painfully deciphered and copied and re-copied the manuscripts which they had saved. By degrees, the woody swamp became a hermitage, a religious house, a farm, an abbey, a village, a seminary, a school of learning, and a city." These cities helped reestablish Western Civilization.

St. Benedict, pray for us; Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us!

San Benito de Nursia - 11 de julio

Esta semana, el 11 de julio, la Iglesia celebra a un santo conocido por varias razones instrumentales. A menudo se le atribuye la salvación de la cultura cristiana occidental tras la caída del Imperio Romano. También se le conoce como el Padre del Monacato. Otros quizás lo conozcan por su medalla. Se trata de San Benito de Nursia.

Aunque muchos reconocen su nombre por algunas de las razones mencionadas, se conocen relativamente pocos datos biográficos concretos sobre él. Nació hacia el año 480, hijo de un noble romano de Nursia, en el centro de Italia. Fue enviado a Roma para cursar estudios, pero quedó decepcionado por la corrupción moral que imperaba en la ciudad pocos años después de la caída del Imperio. Se retiró de Roma y permaneció en una cueva. Cerca de allí conoció a un monje llamado Romano de Subiaco y se hizo ermitaño. En su soledad, maduró y se acercó más a Dios.

Fue sacado de la cueva por unos monjes cercanos cuyo abad había muerto. Benito se convirtió en su abad. Los otros monjes no estaban contentos con la disciplina que Benito trataba de imponer e intentaron envenenarlo dos veces. Abandonó el monasterio y fundó doce nuevos monasterios, terminando con el gran Monte Cassino.

Benito escribió lo que se conoce como La Regla de San Benito para los monjes que vivían bajo la autoridad de un abad. Los monasterios que fundó seguían este modo de vida. La Regla presupone la autonomía de cada comunidad; por tanto, Benito no pretendía formar una nueva orden religiosa, pero estos monasterios evolucionaron hacia una.

San John Henry Newman escribe sobre la naturaleza de la renovación y la reforma influidas por el monacato benedictino de antaño. "Se observaba a hombres silenciosos por el campo cavando, desbrozando y construyendo. Otros descifraban, copiaban y volvían a copiar penosamente los manuscritos que habían salvado. Poco a poco, el pantano boscoso se convirtió en una ermita, una casa religiosa, una granja, una abadía, un pueblo, un seminario, una escuela de aprendizaje y una ciudad". Estas ciudades ayudaron a restablecer la civilización occidental.
