Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

The Beatitudes praise the poor in spirit. One characteristic of those who are poor in spirit is their ability to ask for help; they know when others can provide what they lack. Today's readings encourage us to practice poverty in spirit by asking God for what we need. What could be more natural than to ask God for good things? God is, after all, the inventor of goodness and the giver of all good things.

Asking God for help puts us in conversation with God. These conversations take many forms. The reading from Genesis shows Abraham bantering with God like a skilled negotiator, while Saint Paul's letter to the Colossians praises God for answering us even when we don't deserve it. In Saint Luke's Gospel, Jesus not only gives us words to use in our conversations with God (the Our Father) but also promises that God always listens to our prayers.

When was the last time you really stopped and had a real conversation with God? Adoration is a good time to talk to our Father in heaven. But you must remember to talk and then listen. If we do not listen we cannot have a good conversation.

¿Cuándo fue la última vez que realmente te detuviste y tuviste una verdadera conversación con Dios? La adoración es un buen momento para hablar con Nuestro Padre celestial. Pero debes recordar de hablar y luego escuchar. Si no escuchamos no podemos tener una buena conversación.

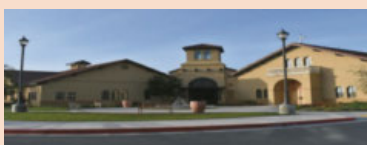

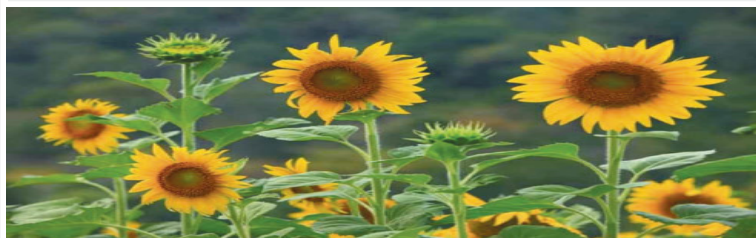

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

"Ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you." Sounds lovely, doesn't it? I remember understanding this verse as though God is like a genie in a bottle and prayer is like a delivery service. But when I encountered true hardship, this interpretation was tested. I was seeking, but I couldn't find what I wanted. My request seemed to go unanswered. I was asking, but my hands were empty. I couldn't reconcile this. Did this mean God wasn't telling me the truth? Trusting that couldn't be the case, I pressed in a little harder. In time, and through the grace of God, I realized I'd been reading this verse through selfish eyes. I was understanding this passage to say, "ask for whatever you feel like in the moment, and I'll drop it on your doorstep." But what does Jesus *actually* say? He says that if we ask, he will always give us *the Holy Spirit*. This understanding can change how we pray. The Lord doesn't promise to instantly cure our maladies, or to remove every ounce of pain on this side of the veil. But he does promise to send his Advocate, the Holy Spirit, to be with us through it all. And that is far better than any type of delivery service.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Today's psalm echoes the Gospel message that the Lord never abandons us. In our response, we unite our voices with the universal Church as we say, "Lord, on the day I called for help, you answered me." We encounter hardship on a daily basis. From the tiny irritations that tempt our tempers to flare to the heavy crosses we carry, we are reminded of how much we need God's help. And yet, how often is our response to turn inward and grow weary, discouraged, or angry? Next time we come eye to eye with a challenge, let's try to respond like the psalmist, and cry out to the Advocate. He is very near. *Come Holy Spirit.*

REFLECT

We are reminded in today's readings that the Lord is always near, that he hears us, and that he responds generously. Thank God this is true even when it doesn't seem like it. As we face our daily hardships, let's not forget to ask Jesus for help. Don't forget that he never rations the Spirit, and though he will never force himself on you, he's waiting eagerly to pour his love into your heart. Ask! Seek! Knock! He knows your voice, and he is ready to respond.

Jubilee 2025 – Jubilee of Youth

The Jubilee of Young people runs from July 28 through August 3. This jubilee event is geared toward people ages 18-35. Young people from around the world are heading to Rome to participate in this celebration.

The Jubilee of Youth kicks off on Tuesday, July 29, with a Welcome Holy Mass in Saint Peter's Square. On Wednesday and Thursday, various cultural, spiritual, and artistic events are planned throughout the city of Rome. The coffin containing the incorrupt body of Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati will be on display in Rome at the Basilica of Santa Maria Sopra Minerva for veneration. He, along with Blessed Carlo Acutis, are scheduled to be declared saints on September 7th. On Wednesday, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) will be hosting a National U.S. Pilgrim Gathering at the Papal Basilica of St. Paul outside the Walls in Rome. There will be a procession, concluding at the Holy Door, followed by a Eucharistic Holy Hour, and remarks by Bishop Robert Barron and Bishop Edward Burns, the Chairman and Chairman-Elect of the USCCB Committee of Laity, Marriage, Family Life, and Youth.

Friday, August 1, is designated as a penitential day with reconciliation at the Circus Maximus. The liturgies with Pope Leo XIV will likely be televised as well. We should all be praying for all the young people in our parish and communities during the Jubilee.

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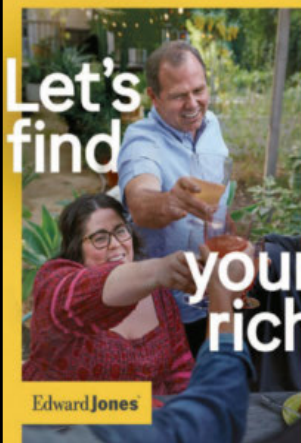


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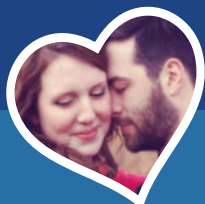
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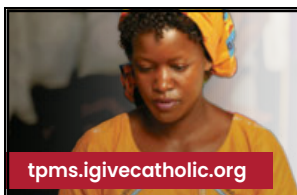
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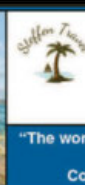
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Vacation Bible School
