Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

Notice how the gospel begins: "When Jesus heard about the death of John the Baptist, he withdrew in a boat to a deserted place by himself." Jesus probably wanted some time to grieve the loss of his cousin and friend. Even so, "His heart was move with pity for them and he cured their sick." Rather than choosing anger or retaliation, Jesus cares for others in their time of need. This certainly does not suggest that people do not need time to grieve. Grief is important and necessary. It does show, however, that Jesus chooses love and compassion, rather than retaliation.

Today's gospel is also somewhat terrifying. When the disciples approached Jesus and told him to release the crowds, they probably did not expect the answer they received. Rather than dismissing the crowds or working some sort of miracle, Jesus simply says: "Give them some food yourselves." This is almost like a pre-missioning missioning of the disciples. Fortunately, Jesus does intervene and the thousands are satisfied. Like those disciples, we all have a role to play in bringing about God's kingdom on earth.

The prophet Isaiah tells of God's care for God's people, "All you who are thirsty, come to the water! You who have no money come, receive grain and eat." But God works through us. Saint Teresa of Avila, a prominent Spanish mystic, wrote, "Christ has no body now but yours, no hands, no feet on earth but yours. Yours are the eyes with which he looks with compassion on this world." God trusts and empowers us to do God's work. Let us make this prayer our own today.

Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us.

Fíjate cómo comienza el evangelio: "Cuando Jesús se enteró de la muerte de Juan el Bautista, se retiró en barca a un lugar desierto él solo." Probablemente Jesús quería tiempo para llorar la pérdida de su primo y amigo. Aun así, "Su corazón se movió con compasión por ellos y curó a sus enfermos." En lugar de elegir la ira o la represalia, Jesús se preocupa por los demás en su momento de necesidad. Esto ciertamente no significa que la gente no necesite tiempo para llorar. El duelo es importante y necesario. Sin embargo, muestra que Jesús elige el amor y la compasión, en lugar de la represalia.

El evangelio de hoy también resulta algo aterrador. Cuando los discípulos se acercaron a Jesús y le dijeron que soltara a la multitud, probablemente no esperaban la respuesta que recibieron. En lugar de desestimar a las multitudes o realizar algún tipo de milagro, Jesús simplemente dice: "Dadles algo de comida vosotros mismos." Esto es casi como una misión previa a la misión de los discípulos. Por suerte, Jesús interviene y los miles quedan satisfechos. Como esos discípulos, todos tenemos un papel que desempeñar en traer el reino de Dios en la tierra.

El profeta Isaías habla del cuidado de Dios por su pueblo: "¡Todos los que tenéis sed, venid al agua! Vosotros, que no tenéis dinero, venid y recibid grano y comed." Pero Dios obra a través de nosotros. Santa Teresa de Avila, destacada mística española, escribió: "Cristo no tiene ahora cuerpo más que el tuyo, ni manos, ni pies en la tierra que no sean los tuyos. Tus ojos son los que él muestra compasión en este mundo." Dios confía en nosotros y nos capacita para hacer la obra de Dios. Hagamos nuestro pago hoy mismo.

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

In one of the best homilies I ever heard on today's Gospel, the homilist pointed out that the Lord had seemingly "over-multiplied" the loaves and fish. The crowds had eaten to the point of satisfaction, and yet there were twelve baskets of leftovers remaining. "Why so many leftovers? Did the Lord not know how to count?" He asked jokingly, of course. But the point the homilist went on to share that day was that with God, there is always abundance. God doesn't simply provide the bare minimum of what we need for *survival*; the Scriptures tell us that he provides "rich fare" that will "satisfy the desire of every living thing." As we reflect on today's readings, let us not question the Lord's ways, but trust in the abundant generosity of God that satisfies all our needs.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Moments in which God provides for our every need strengthen our faith in him. Yet when difficulties come, we know that God never abandons us. Saint Paul's Letter to the Romans speaks about the unshakable confidence Paul has in God's love for us, despite the difficulties (including shipwreck, beatings, and imprisonment) he endured: "What will separate us from the love of Christ? Will anguish, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or the sword?" "No," he says. Nothing "will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus." Take stock of times in your life when God's providence has carried you through difficult times. Consider ways you can share these moments with others as part of your testimony. When our faith rests on a deep awareness of God's faithful love in our lives, we will be able to bear a compelling witness of his goodness to others.

ACCOMPANIMENT

In the Gospel, God shows his loving care by providing for the needs of his people in practical ways. Consider one way you might be able to accompany others going through periods of challenge or trial by providing practical help. This might look like preparing a meal for a new mom in the throes of postpartum, helping with yardwork for a fellow parishioner recovering from surgery, or helping gather classroom supplies for a teacher serving in an impoverished district. In these simple yet concrete ways, we manifest the abundance of God's care and concern for each and every person.

Devotions, Explained! Holy Hour

Mini Explanation — A holy hour is the practice of spending one hour's time in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament, praying and meditating on the agony of Jesus Christ.

Holy Hour, Explained!

A holy hour is the practice of spending one hour's time in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament, praying and meditating on the agony of Jesus Christ. More broadly, a holy hour can also refer to any 60 minutes set aside in prayer and reflection, whether in church or elsewhere.

The holy hour devotion dates to the late 17th century, when St. Margaret Mary Alacoque received visions of Jesus Christ. In these visions, the Lord requested that St. Margaret Mary spend one hour every Thursday evening lying prostrate and meditating upon his agony in the Garden of Gethsemane. This practice calls back to the Gospel of Matthew, which tells of Jesus' desire for the disciples to "remain here and keep watch with me" (Matthew 26:38) as he awaited his passion.

Holy hours can be made privately or in community, and the USCCB has created a variety of different holy hour formats that can be found at:

Una hora santa es la práctica de pasar una hora en presencia del Santísimo Sacramento, rezando y meditando sobre la agonía de Jesucristo. En un sentido más amplio, una hora santa también puede referirse a cualquier periodo de 60 minutos dedicado a la oración y la reflexión, ya sea en la iglesia o en cualquier otro lugar.

La devoción de la hora santa se remonta a finales del siglo XVII, cuando Santa Margarita María Alacoque recibió visiones de Jesucristo. En estas visiones, el Señor pidió a Santa Margarita María que dedicara una hora cada jueves por la tarde a postrarse en el suelo y meditar sobre su agonía en el Huerto de Getsemaní. Esta práctica remite al Evangelio de Mateo, que narra el deseo de Jesús de que los discípulos "permanecieran allí y velaran con él" (Mateo 26, 38) mientras esperaba su pasión.

Las horas santas pueden celebrarse en privado o en comunidad, y la USCCB ha creado una variedad de formatos de horas santas que pueden encontrarse en usccb.org/prayer-and-worship/prayers-and-devotions/eucharistic-devotion

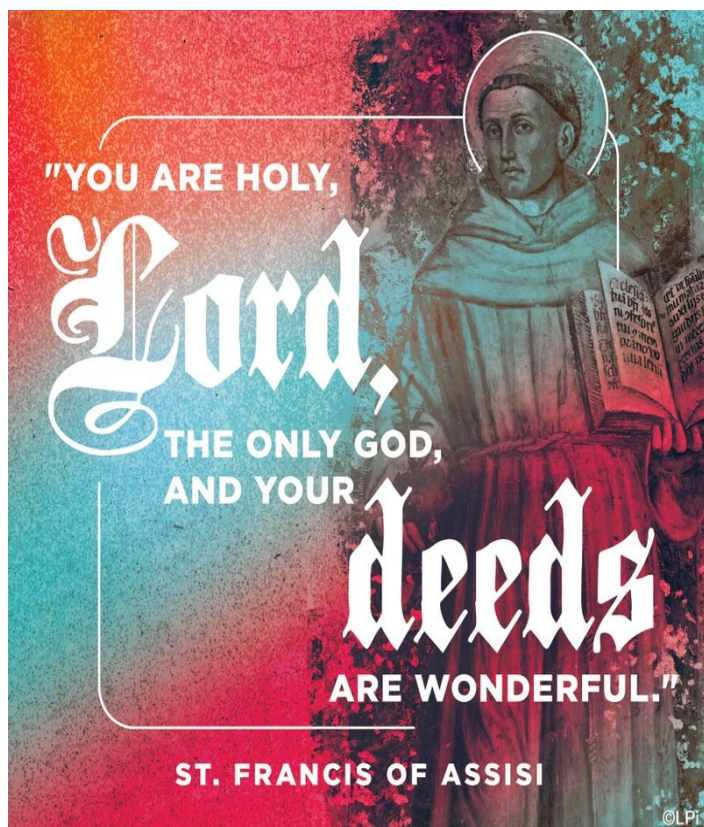

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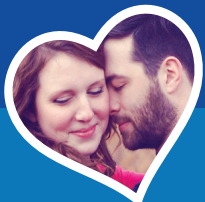
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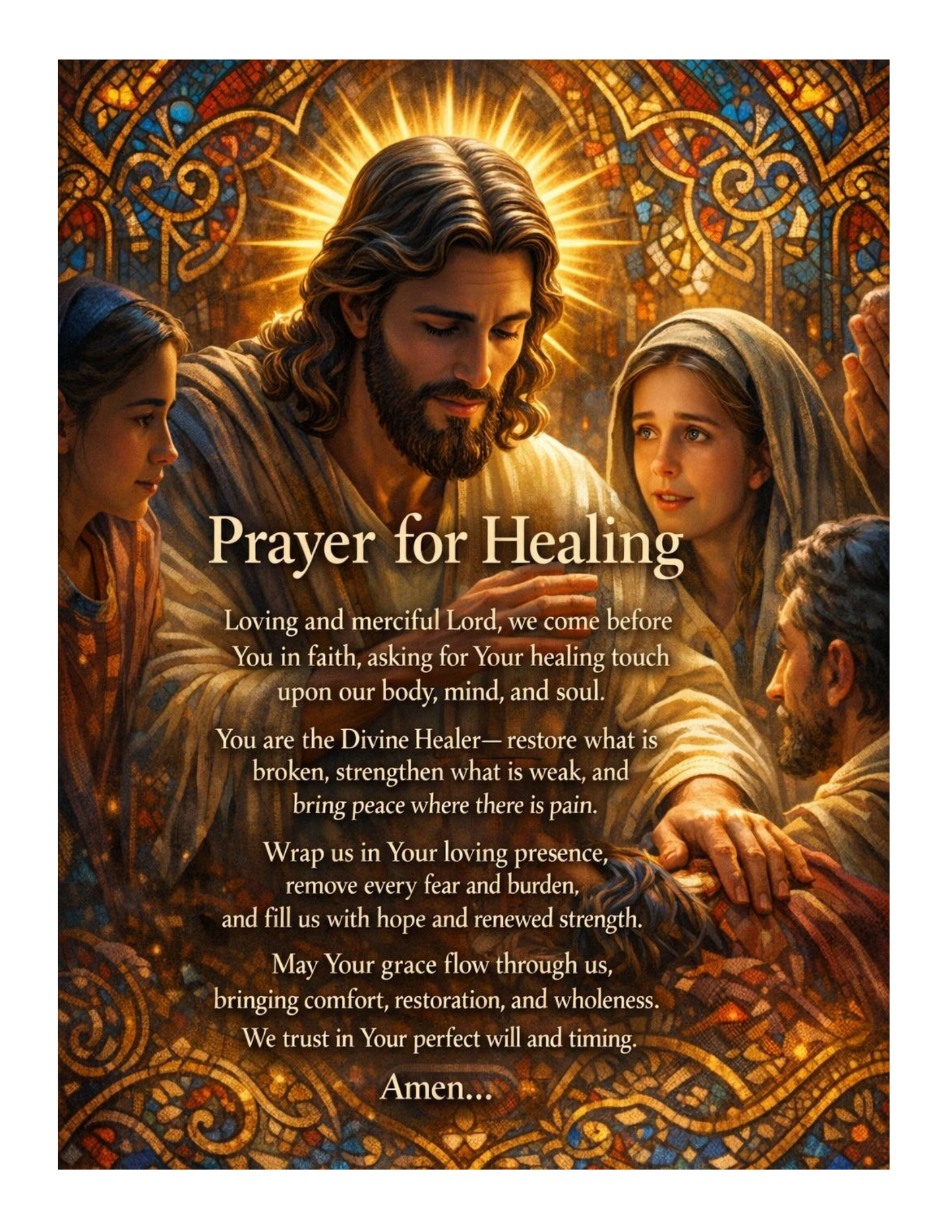
