Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Today's readings acknowledge the real challenges of living our faith. Following Christ will sometimes put us at odds with others – an uncomfortable reality that many will face in our broken and divided world. Yet we can find strength knowing that Jesus understands the constant opposition (both inward and outward) that we face. The second reading says, "Consider how he endured such opposition from sinners." Jesus knows what it's like to face opposition, but he endured it "for the sake of the joy that lay before him." That is our calling too. We are made to know the joy that awaits us beyond our crosses. We find the strength to persevere through our trials by "keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus." Keeping Christ as our focus, we will be able to overcome any obstacle we may face and run toward the goal of heaven.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

In today's Gospel, Jesus said, "I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing." Jesus' desire is that the whole world be set aflame with his love, and yet, he knows that this will not come easily. The good news is that Jesus is with us in the midst of the struggle. He too knows the deep longing and even anguish (the Gospel today uses that word!) that we experience as we work so that others may come to know God's love. We can take comfort in the fact that as much as we want to see others come to faith, God desires it even more than we do, and he is also pouring out his grace continually upon us. In the midst of any discouragement we may feel about those who seem opposed to God and to faith, may we remember the burning love that Christ has and his immense desire to draw all people to himself.

PRAY

Pray for those whom you may know who seem closed to the Gospel, or who are away from the Church. Invite the Holy Spirit to touch your heart with a particular love and zeal to pray for them, that those who may seem the most opposed to faith might come, one day, to embrace it.

Our Lady of Knock - August 21

A historical memorial that is not part of the new Church calendar, but is likely still well-known by some, is Our Lady of Knock, on August 21. Knock is an Irish village in County Mayo in the northwest part of Ireland. On August 21, 1879, Mary Byrne was going home from the church with the priest's housekeeper, Mary McLoughlin. She stopped suddenly when she saw three life-sized figures floating several feet above the ground.

She ran home to tell her parents, and they returned along with other villagers. The heavy mist that lingered all day turned into a steady downpour. They saw the Blessed Virgin Mary dressed in white robes with a gold crown on her head, with a single golden rose. Her hands and eyes turned toward heaven in prayer. On her right was St. Joseph. His head was respectfully bowed toward Our Lady. His hands were together in prayer. On her left was St. John the Evangelist. He was vested in Bishop's robes and a mitre. He held a book open with his arms outstretched as if he were preaching, but no voice was heard. On his left was an altar on which stood a lamb with a cross behind it. Despite the steady rain and strong wind, the ground underneath the apparition remained dry.

The witnesses remained there in the rain, praying the Rosary for two hours. After the apparition ended, people would come and take pieces of the wall behind the apparition's site, believing them to be holy. The Archbishop of Tuam, the diocese that includes Knock, later approved of the apparitions, and declared the witness's testimony trustworthy. Pilgrimages to Knock began soon after and continue to this day, especially in August. A Church was built in 1976 to honor Our Lady, Queen of Ireland. In 1979, Pope John Paul II visited and elevated it to a Basilica. In 2011, Ireland's National Eucharistic Congress was held there. In 2018, Pope Francis visited.

Although no words were spoken, the symbolism in the apparition is rich in meaning. St. Joseph represents the laity, and St. John the hierarchy. Mary is the model of the Church in its perfection. The Lamb on the altar shows the Eucharistic liturgy that holds together the three.

Nuestra Señora de Knock - 21 de agosto

Una conmemoración histórica que no forma parte del nuevo calendario litúrgico, pero que probablemente siga siendo conocida por algunos, es Nuestra Señora de Knock, el 21 de agosto. Knock es un pueblo irlandés situado en el condado de Mayo, en el noroeste de Irlanda. El 21 de agosto de 1879, Mary Byrne regresaba a casa desde la iglesia con la ama de llaves del sacerdote, Mary McLoughlin. Se detuvo de repente cuando vio tres figuras de tamaño natural flotando a varios metros del suelo.

Corrió a casa para contárselo a sus padres, y ellos regresaron junto con otros aldeanos. La espesa niebla que había permanecido todo el día se convirtió en un aguacero constante. Vieron a la Santísima Virgen María vestida con túnicas blancas y una corona de oro en la cabeza, con una sola rosa dorada. Sus manos y sus ojos se volvieron hacia el cielo en oración. A su derecha estaba San José. Su cabeza estaba respetuosamente inclinada hacia Nuestra Señora. Sus manos estaban juntas en oración. A su izquierda estaba San Juan Evangelista. Vestía ropas de obispo y una mitra. Sostenía un libro abierto con los brazos extendidos como si estuviera predicando, pero no se oía ninguna voz. A su izquierda había un altar sobre el que se encontraba un cordero con una cruz detrás. A pesar de la lluvia constante y el fuerte viento, el suelo debajo de la aparición permaneció seco.

Los testigos permanecieron allí bajo la lluvia, rezando el rosario durante dos horas. Una vez finalizada la aparición, la gente acudía a llevarse trozos de la pared situada detrás del lugar de la aparición, creyendo que eran sagrados. El arzobispo de Tuam, diócesis a la que pertenece Knock, aprobó posteriormente las apariciones y declaró fiable el testimonio de los testigos. Las peregrinaciones a Knock comenzaron poco después y continúan hasta hoy, especialmente en agosto. En 1976 se construyó una iglesia en honor a Nuestra Señora, Reina de Irlanda. En 1979, el papa Juan Pablo II la visitó y la elevó a basílica. En 2011 se celebró allí el Congreso Eucarístico Nacional de Irlanda. En 2018 la visitó el papa Francisco.

Aunque no se pronunciaron palabras, el simbolismo de la aparición es rico en significado. San José representa a los laicos y San Juan a la jerarquía. María es el modelo de la Iglesia en su perfección. El Cordero en el altar muestra la liturgia eucarística que une a los tres.
