Dear Families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

Sacrifice and suffering are inextricable from the Christian story. Following God's call comes at great cost. In the first reading, Jeremiah shares honestly with God about his own experience of suffering, even blaming God for his derision by others.

In the gospel, Jesus tells the apostles that he must be crucified, offering himself as sacrifice for our sins. Paul encourages us to follow in Christ's example offering ourselves as "a living sacrifice" to God.

We do not always want the messiah we have. Sometimes, we wish God would have sent someone to end global hunger and maintain world peace. And others, like the Zealots in Christ's day, wish we had a divinely authorized political leader who could "fix things" and put all those we disagree with in their place. God gave us neither. Instead, he sent us his Son, who became one of us and entered our own suffering for us. To follow that Messiah is not always easy. It is uncomfortable, requires us to "turn the other cheeks," and mandate that we stop grasping for control. But as Jesus said, "Whoever loses his life for my sake will find it."

Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us.

El sacrificio y el sufrimiento son inseparables de la historia cristiana. Seguir el llamado de Dios tiene un gran costo. En la primera lectura, Jeremías comparte honestamente con Dios su propia experiencia de sufrimiento, incluso culpando a Dios por su burla hacia los demás. En el evangelio, Jesús dice a los apóstoles que debe ser crucificado, ofreciéndose como sacrificio por nuestros pecados. Pablo nos anima a seguir el ejemplo de Cristo, ofreciéndonos como "un sacrificio viviente" a Dios.

No siempre queremos al mesías que tenemos. A veces, deseáramos que Dios hubiera enviado a alguien para ayudar a combatir el hambre global y mantener la paz mundial. En otros, nos gustan los Zelotes en tiempos de Cristo, deseamos tener un líder político autorizado por Dios que pudiera "arreglar las cosas" y poner en su lugar a todos los que no estamos de acuerdo. Dios no nos dio ninguno de los dos. En cambio, nos envió a su Hijo, que se convirtió en uno de nosotros y entró en nuestro propio sufrimiento por nosotros. Seguir ese Mesías no siempre es fácil. Es incómodo, nos obliga a "poner la otra mejilla" y a que dejemos de buscar el control. Pero como dijo Jesús, "Quien pierde la vida por mí la encontrará."

Inmaculado Corazón de María, ruega por nosotros.

Fr. Gilberto Chávez was born in Santa Isabel, Chihuahua, Mexico in 1971. He is the oldest of 7 children. He belongs to the Religious Order of the Servants of Jesus (S. de J). He studied philosophy in Puebla, Mexico, and theology in Toledo, Spain and was ordained to the priesthood on July 25th, 2000 at the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Mexico. He served in vocations ministry as a promoter for 4 years — half of that time in Puebla and the other half in Guadalajara, Mexico.

Most of his priestly ministry has been in parishes:

7 years in the Archdiocese of Mexico; 3 years in the Archdiocese of Tegucigalpa, Honduras; and 6 years in Olanchito, Diocese of Yoro, Honduras.

He studied Biblical Theology at the Gregorian University in Rome and taught Sacred Scripture for a year and a half at Our Lady of Suyapa Seminary in Tegucigalpa, Honduras.

Before coming to the United States, he assisted at Santiago Momoxpan Parish in Puebla, Mexico for 10 months.

Since December 2025, he has served as parochial vicar at the clustered parishes of St. David of Wales, Richmond & St. John the Baptist in San Lorenzo, of our Diocese.

As of September 1st of this year,

he has been appointed Parochial Vicar at Immaculate Heart of Mary Church.

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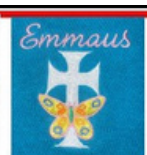

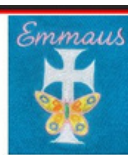

When I Called, You Answered

Some of us have that friend about whom we are constantly discovering new things. Maybe we've known this person for ten or even twenty years, and one day at lunch we'll find out they're a direct descendant of a dead president or they once met a major celebrity.

"You never asked," they'll say with a shrug.

As annoying as this can be, it makes perfect sense, doesn't it? We never asked. There is something strangely sacred about the act of asking for something. It requires humility. It requires grace. It requires us to be awake, to be aware, to be vulnerable.

Too often we fall into a pattern of entitlement, even when it comes to information. We go through life thinking that a great cosmic conveyor belt of what we want is going to roll on past us, and we'll barely even have to extend our arms. We read our Bible and we hear all these amazing promises from the Father who loves us, and we get sort of complacent. He's got this, we think, and we shut our eyes to take a snooze on the road trip of life, confident that someone else is going to look out for stop signs and wrong turns.

It's true: God's got this. He is going to take care of us. But He wants us to be in relationship with Him. He wants us to be an active, receptive participant in our own salvation. See his patience with Abraham's entreaties on behalf of the righteous of Sodom: He wants to answer, not simply to tell.

He wants us to stay awake for the drive.

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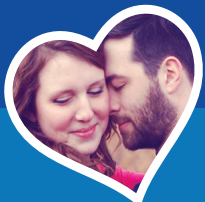
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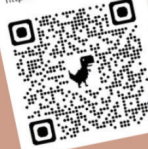
