Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

Exodus recounts the journey of the Israelites out of slavery in Egypt to the land promised to their ancestors. It was not an easy journey. In today's reading, they are attacked by Amalek and his soldiers, members of one of the peoples who live in the land through which the Israelites are traveling. Moses was on the hilltop with his arms raised to invoke the LORD's assistance in the battle below, a powerful illustration of the LORD's favor upon Israel. If the soldiers were to lift up their eyes to that hill (see Psalm 121:1), they would be reassured by Moses's presence and posture.

Paul urges the Thessalonians to persist in proclaiming the gospel, and Jesus likewise commends the widow for her persistence in pursuit of the justice due her. Whether they preach or pray, the followers of Jesus need persistence through periods of difficulty.

We are no different. Persistence is needed if we are to hear God speaking to us. To follow his will. Allow the Holy Spirit to guide us. Without persistence we can not move forward to God's will.

Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us.

El libro del Éxodo narra el viaje de los israelitas desde la esclavitud en Egipto hasta la tierra prometida a sus antepasados. No fue un viaje fácil. En la lectura de hoy, son atacados por Amalec y sus soldados, integrantes de uno de los pueblos que habitaba por donde pasaron los israelitas. Moisés estaba en la cima de la montaña con los brazos levantados para invocar la ayuda del Señor en la batalla que estaba ocurriendo colina abajo, un ejemplo poderoso del favor del Señor sobre Israel. Si los soldados estuvieran con sus ojos hacia la colina (ver salmo 121:1), se sentirían tranquilos por la presencia y postura de Moisés.

Pablo insta a los tesalonicenses a que perseveren en la proclamación del Evangelio, y Jesús elogia igualmente a la viuda por su persistencia en la búsqueda de la justicia que le corresponde. Ya sea que prediquen u oren, los seguidores de Jesús necesitan de la perseverancia en los periodos de dificultad.

Nosotros no somos diferentes. La persistencia es necesaria si queremos escuchar a Dios hablándonos. Para seguir su voluntad. Permitir que el Espíritu Santo nos guíe. Sin persistencia no podemos avanzar hacia la voluntad de Dios.

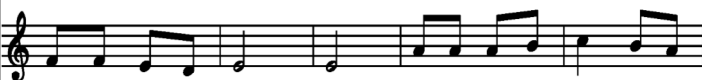

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

We're all familiar with the refrain to pray without ceasing. It starts with Moses, who keeps his hands raised with the staff of God while war waged against Israel. It carries over to the Apostles, and St. Paul gives Timothy the exhortation to "be persistent whether it is convenient or inconvenient." Jesus affirms in the parable of the persistent widow how important it is "to pray always without becoming weary." As Christians, we understand the importance of prayer, but to pray always and constantly? Especially in today's world filled with distractions, this seems like an impossible task. Even Moses grew weary! But persistence is the name of the game in prayer. When prayer becomes difficult and no longer flows, we, like Moses receiving support to keep his hands steady until the battle was won, can receive support from the Holy Spirit. We simply must push forward and ask for help because Christ assures us God will "secure the rights of his chosen ones who call out to him day and night."

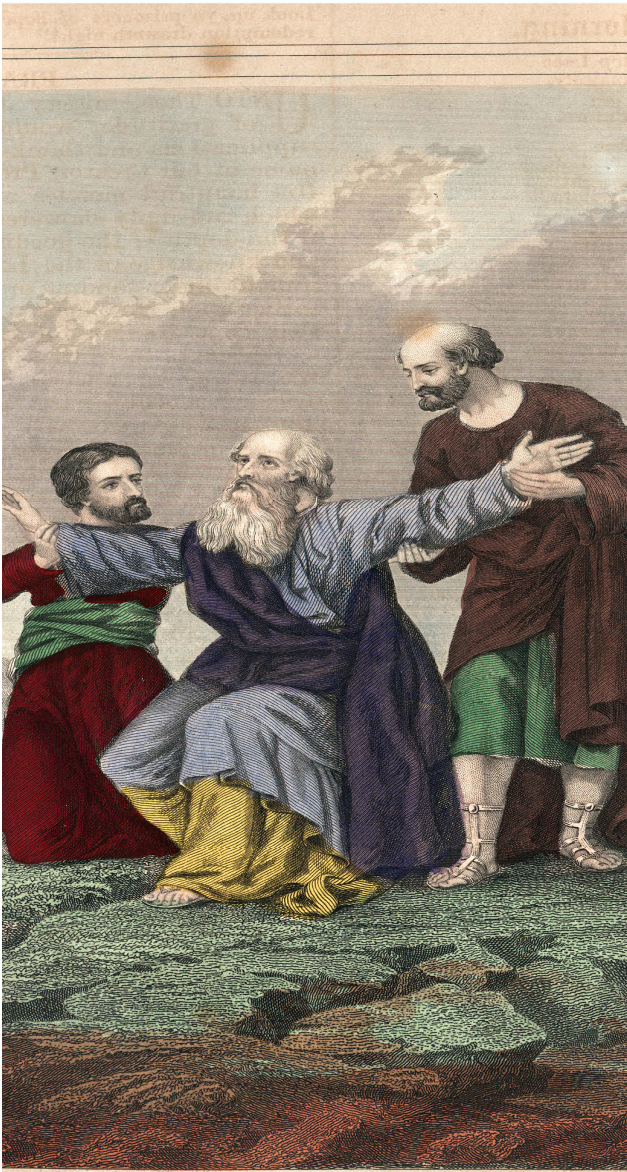
GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Prayer does not only consist of mental or vocal pleas to God; rather, it includes praise and thanksgiving and petition, all of which can be offered through simply living. We can consecrate our daily actions and offer them up to God as a living prayer: dropping the kids off at school with a special blessing in Christ's name to conquer the day; biting our tongue and inviting the Holy Spirit into a situation when dealing with a difficult person; or sitting at the dinner table filled with thanksgiving for our food and family. Prayer then isn't something we simply *do*, it is something we *live*.

PRAY

Choose an action that will serve as a trigger to encourage you to pray. Do you hear sirens as you're heading to work? Say a "Hail Mary" for those who may be in harm's way. Are you scrolling through social media and find a friend sharing their struggle? Offer a quick prayer for their need. Train yourself to pray - something as simple as, "Lord Jesus have mercy on (N.)" or "Lord look graciously upon their need" - and you'll find yourself praying without even thinking about it.

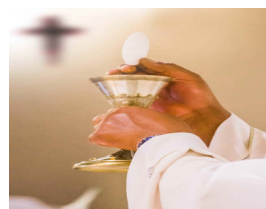

For the reception of Holy Communion either kneeling or standing is permitted. If standing a bow of the head is necessary as an act of adoration. If receiving on the tongue you should extend your tongue not just open your mouth. If receiving on your hand place one hand on the other and not use your fingers to receive the host. Immediately step to the side and place the host in your mouth. Do not walk with the host. When the priest or minister says "Body of Christ" your response should be "Amen"

Para recibir la Sagrada Comunión se permite estar arrodillado o de pie. Si se está de pie es necesario inclinar la cabeza como acto de adoración. Si se recibe en la lengua se debe extender la lengua y no sólo abrir la boca. Si se recibe en la mano, se debe colocar una mano sobre la otra y no usar los dedos para recibir la hostia. Inmediatamente, hagase a un lado y coloque la hostia en su boca. No camine con la hostia. Cuando el sacerdote o ministro dice "Cuerpo de Cristo" su respuesta debe ser "Amén".
