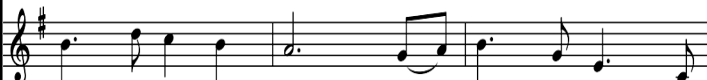

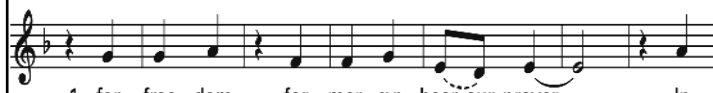

Ex 17:8-13 | 2 Tim 3:14-4:2 | Luke 18:1-8

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Studying Scripture is not a side dish on the plate of practicing the faith. It is an essential component of the virtuous life, and without it, our faith will surely falter. In his second letter to Timothy, Saint Paul reminds us that the Scriptures are the inspired Word of God and they train us in righteous living and equip us for every good work. There will undoubtedly be times when we feel ill-equipped – when we are fatigued, frustrated, or concerned. It is precisely in these moments that we're invited to go quickly to the holy Word of God! Read it, pray with it, and invite the Spirit to speak to you through it. There you will find the wisdom needed to face every circumstance.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Our faith journey was never meant to be a solitary endeavor! We see this in today's first reading when Aaron and Hur stand beside Moses, holding his weary arms in the air as the battle rages on against the Amalekites. This image of the three men on the mountain – Moses with his arms raised high, Aaron and Hur on either side supporting them – is a powerful image of companionship in the Christian life. When you feel too weary to pray, look around – the Lord has likely given you companions who can support you precisely in the ways you need at this time. Pay attention, too, to who God might be inviting you to support in prayer. Our Gospel tells us that God always hears our prayer and calls us to be persistent in prayer. Certainly, God will "secure the rights of his chosen ones who call out to him day and night." God calls us to persist in prayer because it reveals our faith and trust in him that we constantly bring our needs before him.

REFLECT

Our readings offer helpful tools to turn to when discouragement or isolation may cloud our spiritual vision. Take some time this week to listen to the Lord's voice in Scripture. Or, if you're feeling weary, ask a few friends to pray with and for you. Remember that although God may seem distant, he always hears us. Be persistent in bringing your needs to him and wait with patience – surely, he will come swiftly to your aid.

North American Martyrs & 40 Martyrs of England and Wales

This week, the Church recognizes and celebrates two large groups of martyrs. October 19 is dedicated to the North American Martyrs, a group of eight Jesuit missionaries in what is now southern Ontario, Canada, and upstate New York. October 25 is for the Forty Martyrs of England and Wales. Tertullian once wrote, "The blood of the martyrs is the seed of the church."

In 1639, French Jesuit missionaries established a settlement called Saint-Marie among the Hurons near Midland, Ontario. It was the first European settlement in Ontario. Father Jean de Brébeuf and Father Gabriel Lalemant founded it. As the name of the settlement implies, the target of the Jesuits' evangelization was the Huron people.

The Hurons were not entirely trusting of the Jesuits, and other bands of Hurons considered the Jesuits fair game for raids and warfare. In 1642, the Mohawks and Hurons went to war, and the Jesuits were caught in the middle of it. All eight were eventually captured and put to death by both Mohawks and Hurons between 1642 and 1649.

A National Shrine of the North American Martyrs was built in Auriesville, New York, in 1884. In Canada, the Shrine of the Canadian Martyrs was built in 1926.

The Forty Martyrs of England and Wales were a group of lay and religious men and women who were executed between 1535 and 1679 for treason and other related offenses during the English Reformation. The first wave of executions came during the reign of King Henry VIII, involving those who did not support the 1534 Act of Supremacy. Later, during the reign of Elizabeth I, in 1554, Parliament passed the Jesuits, etc. Act. This act required all Roman Catholic priests to leave the country within 40 days or be punished for high treason. This is the statute under which most suffered martyrdom. These forty are part of the 284 canonized or beatified martyrs of the English Reformation.

Mártires norteamericanos y 40 mártires de Inglaterra y Gales

Esta semana, la Iglesia reconoce y celebra dos grandes grupos de mártires. El 19 de octubre está dedicado a los Mártires Norteamericanos, un grupo de ocho misioneros jesuitas en lo que ahora es el sur de Ontario, Canadá, y el norte del estado de Nueva York. El 25 de octubre es para los Cuarenta Mártires de Inglaterra y Gales. Tertuliano escribió una vez: "La sangre de los mártires es la semilla de la iglesia".

En 1639, los misioneros jesuitas franceses establecieron un asentamiento llamado Saint-Marie entre los hurones cerca de Midland, Ontario. Fue el primer asentamiento europeo en Ontario. El padre Jean de Brébeuf y el padre Gabriel Lalemant lo fundaron. Como el nombre del asentamiento lo indica, el objetivo de la evangelización de los jesuitas fue el pueblo hurón.

Los hurones no confiaban completamente en los jesuitas, y otras bandas de hurones consideraban que los jesuitas eran presa fácil para las incursiones y la guerra. En 1642, los mohawks y los hurones fueron a la guerra, y los jesuitas quedaron atrapados en medio de ella. Los ocho fueron finalmente capturados y ejecutados tanto por mohawks como por hurones entre 1642 y 1649.

Un Santuario Nacional de los Mártires Norteamericanos fue construido en Auriesville, Nueva York, en 1884. En Canadá, el Santuario de los Mártires Canadienses fue construido en 1926.

Los Cuarenta Mártires de Inglaterra y Gales fueron un grupo de hombres y mujeres laicos y religiosos que fueron ejecutados entre 1535 y 1679 por traición y otros delitos relacionados durante la Reforma inglesa. La primera ola de ejecuciones se produjo durante el reinado del rey Enrique VIII, involucrando a aquellos que no apoyaron el Acta de Supremacía de 1534. Más tarde, durante el reinado de Isabel I, en 1554, el Parlamento aprobó la Ley de los Jesuitas, etc. Esta ley requería que todos los sacerdotes católicos romanos abandonaran el país dentro de los 40 días o serían castigados por alta traición. Este es el estatuto bajo el cual la mayoría sufrió el martirio. Estos cuarenta forman parte de los 284 mártires canonizados o beatificados de la Reforma inglesa.

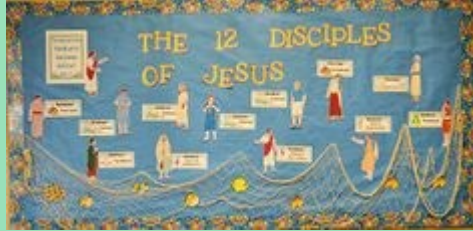

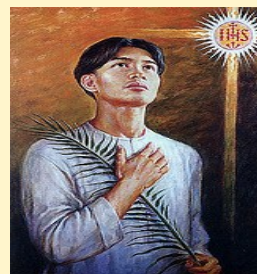

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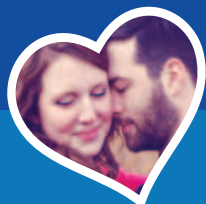
