

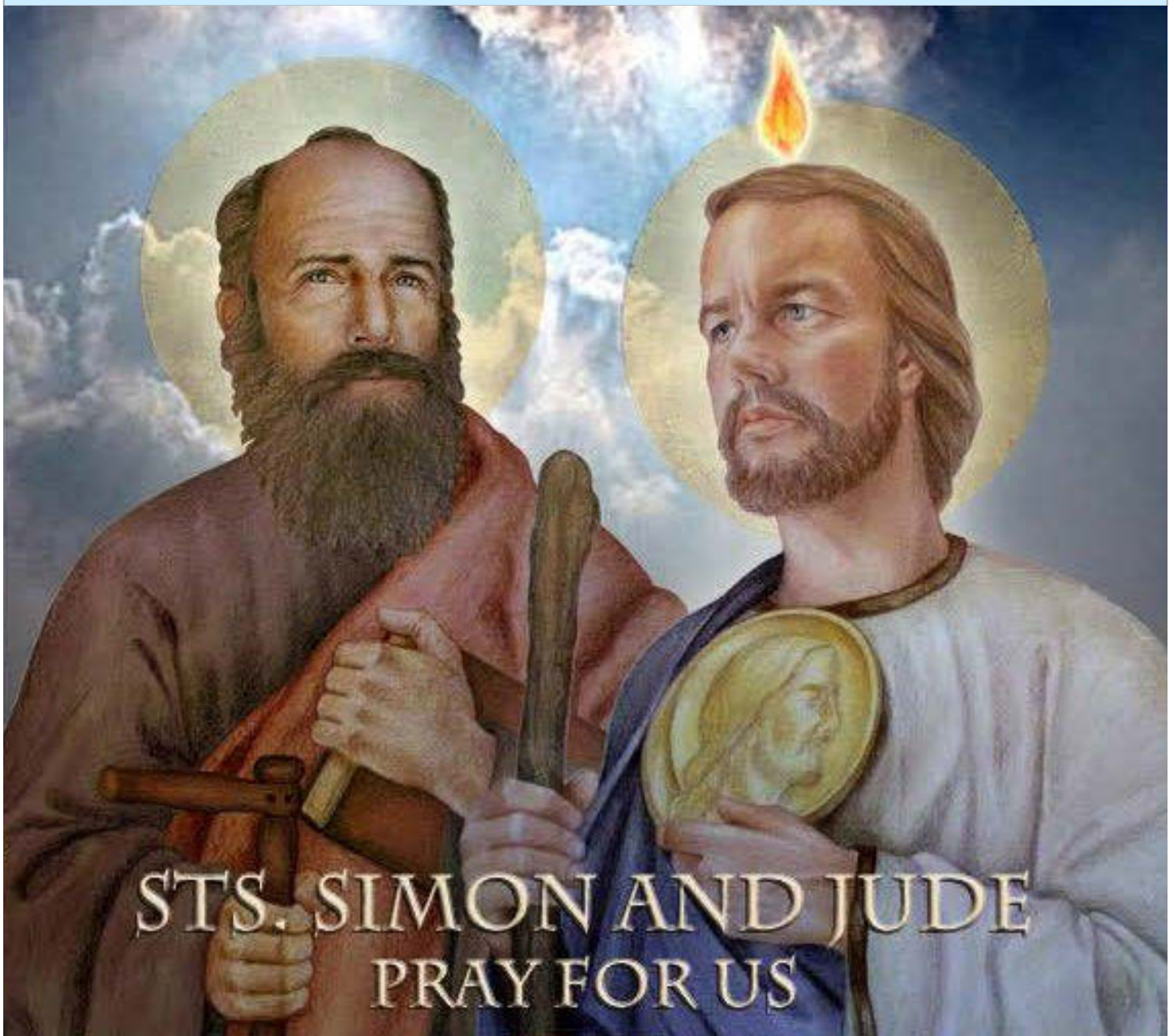

Dear Families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

Although the opening lines of today's first reading claim that the Lord "knows no favorites" (Sirach 35:15) and is "not unduly partial toward the weak" (35:16), the remainder of the passage makes it clear that the Lord does indeed pay special attention to the weak, the oppressed and the orphans and widows. The psalmist reiterates: "The Lord hears the cry of the poor" (see Psalm 34:18).

In the Gospel, Jesus claims that a tax collector is more justified in his prayer for mercy than the Pharisee, whose prayer was an account of his own righteous deeds. Jesus' point could not have been clearer: tax collectors in the Jewish society of Jesus' day were not just lowly; they were considered outcasts and cheaters. They collected taxes for the hated Romans and almost certainly collected enough to assure a generous income for themselves. Tax collectors were among society's outcasts; didn't this one just admit his own sinfulness? How could a tax collector be "justified" (that is, made right) before God, while the Pharisee was not? Why would God even listen to the prayer of a tax collector? This surely was a surprise, upsetting common assumptions about righteousness.

During this Respect Life Month, the faithful need to hear from their shepherds, that all Catholics must, in good conscience, vote to defeat Proposition 1. Prop 1 seeks to extend abortion in our state up to birth and will spend thousands of dollars of our taxpayer money to make CA a "sanctuary" for women seeking to kill their babies from out of state and within our state. It does not eliminate the abortion laws that the state currently has and only makes abortion more accessible and without restriction.

Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us.

Queridas Familias del Inmaculado Corazon de Maria,

Aunque las primeras líneas de la primera lectura de hoy afirman que el Señor "no conoce favoritos" (Eclesiástico 35:15) y no "es indebidamente imparcial con los débiles" (35:16), el resto del pasaje deja claro que el Señor sí pone una atención particular a los débiles, a los oprimidos, a los huérfanos y a las viudas. El salmista reafirma: "El Señor escucha el clamor de los pobres" (ver el salmo 34:18).

En el Evangelio, Jesús afirma que el recolector de impuestos está más justificado en su oración por misericordia que el fariseo, cuya oración era un relato de sus propias acciones justas. La finalidad de Jesús no podía ser más clara: a los recolectores de impuestos en la sociedad judía durante la época de Jesús no solamente se les consideraba miserables, sino también tramposos y eran marginados. Recaudaban impuestos para los odiados romanos y, casi con toda seguridad, recolectaban lo suficiente para asegurarse unos generosos ingresos para ellos mismos. Los recolectores de impuestos estaban entre los marginados de la sociedad, ¿no acababa este de admitir su propia pecaminosidad? ¿Cómo podría un recolector de impuestos ser "justificado" (es decir, hacer a una persona justa) ante Dios, mientras que el fariseo no lo era? ¿Por qué iba Dios a escuchar la oración de un recaudador de impuestos? Esto seguramente fue una sorpresa, perturbando las suposiciones típicas acerca de la justicia.

Durante este Mes del Respeto a la Vida, los fieles necesitan escuchar de sus pastores, que todos los católicos deben, en buena conciencia, votar para derrotar la Propuesta 1. La Propuesta 1 busca extender el aborto en nuestro estado hasta el nacimiento y gastará miles de dólares del dinero de nuestros contribuyentes para hacer de CA un "santuario" para las mujeres que buscan matar a sus bebés desde fuera de nuestro estado y dentro de nuestro estado. No elimina las leyes de aborto que el estado tiene actualmente y sólo hace el aborto más accesible y sin restricciones.

Inmaculado Corazon de Maria, ruega por nosotros.

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

I love baseball. Have you ever seen a batter strike out three times straight, only to hit a game-winning home run or base hit on his fourth at-bat? It doesn't happen often, but when it does, the victory is all the sweeter! I do not believe God actually influences the outcome of baseball games (well, maybe a little; I'm a Cubs fan after all). But I do believe ours is a God who stands by us even in the worst of slumps. Like St. Paul, the key is to keep the faith even when life throws us curveballs, as it inevitably will. If we approach the Lord with the perseverance of Paul and the humility of the tax collector, he will give us the strength we need to finish the race. We can make an effort to approach each day with gratitude, knowing the Lord is always at our side.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Have you heard of Blessed Solanus Casey? He became a Capuchin Franciscan priest, but because of his academic difficulties his ministry was limited. Ordained a "simplex priest," he could say Mass but not preach or hear confessions. And so he was assigned to become a porter, or "doorkeeper." Rather than complain, Father Solanus embraced this ministry. "He was always ready and willing to listen to anyone any time of the day or night," according to the biography read at his beatification in 2017. Because of his humility and holiness, people from all walks of life were drawn to him, often waiting hours to greet him at the door of St. Bonaventure Monastery in Detroit. Hearing today's reading about the prideful Pharisee and the humble tax collector brought his story to mind. Through this parable, Jesus challenges us to approach God and others with humility, understanding that all we are and all we do come from God. We don't have to be the "first," the "best," or the "brightest" - but simply need to ask God to help us grow in love and faith.

ACT Read about Blessed Solanus and recite the "Canonization Prayer," which asks God: "May your will be done in my life today."
