

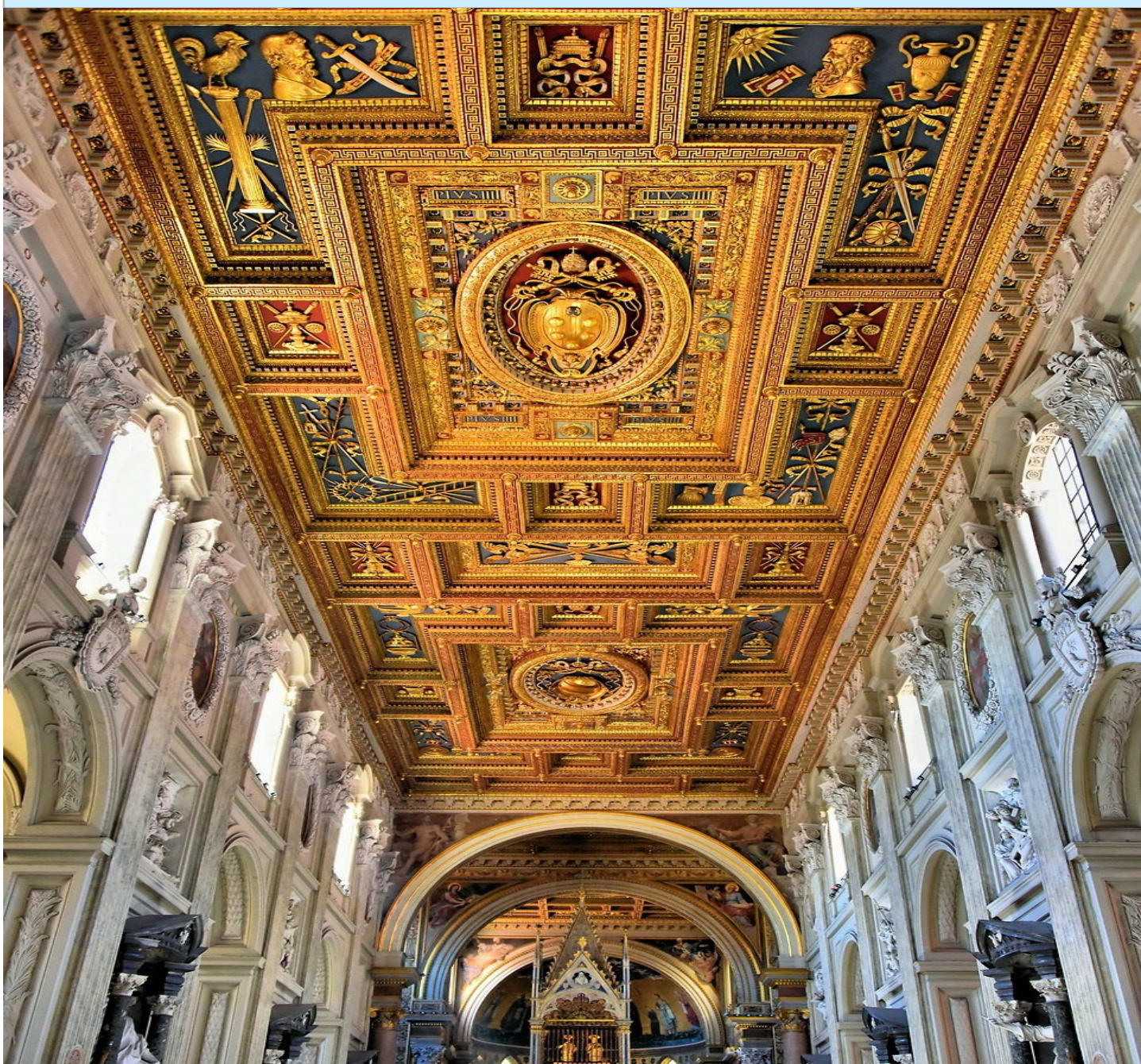

Dear Families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

Today's Gospel Reading invites us into a deeper reflection on the meaning of *church*.

Most Catholics are probably unaware that the Basilica of Saint John Lateran, not St. Peter's, is the seat of the pope. Historically, the church played a larger role than it does now, but it is still one of four major basilicas in Rome. The original church building was dedicated in 324, on property given to the bishop of Rome by Constantine. Additionally, the Lateran Palace was the official residence of the pope until the office moved to Avignon.

John's account of this gospel episode is located at the beginning of the gospel rather than near the end as in the Synoptics. Jesus drives the money-changers and merchants out of the temple area, saying that they were making a market-place out of the Father's house. Animal merchants and money-changers were necessary for temple function, providing the means for animal sacrifice. However, the temple ground was not to be the place for that—even in the outer Court of the Gentiles, where they had likely set up shop. To be holy is to be *set apart*. The temple, of all places was to be dedicated to the worship of God, a space for all people, and the noisiness of bartering crowds was an obstacle to prayer.

Whether grand and ornate (like the Lateran Basilica) or intimate and humble, do our places of worship illuminate their function? Moreover, do we by our actions in these sacred spaces reflect the love of Christ in whose presence we stand?

Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us.

Queridas Familias de Inmaculado Corazón de María,

La lectura del Evangelio de hoy nos invita a una reflexión más profunda sobre el significado de la *iglesia*.

La mayoría de los católicos probablemente no saben que la Basílica de San Juan de Letrán, no la de San Pedro, es la sede del Papa. Históricamente, la iglesia jugó un papel más importante que ahora, pero sigue siendo una de las cuatro basílicas principales de Roma. El edificio original de la iglesia fue dedicado en 324, en una propiedad entregada al obispo de Roma por Constantino. Adicionalmente. El Palacio de Letrán fue la residencia oficial del Papa hasta que la oficina se trasladó a Aviñón.

El relato de Juan de este episodio del evangelio se encuentra al comienzo del evangelio en lugar de cerca del final como en los sinópticos. Jesús expulsa a los cambistas y comerciantes del área del templo, diciendo que estaban haciendo un mercado de la casa del Padre. Los comerciantes de animales y los cambistas eran necesarios para la función del templo, proporcionando los medios para el sacrificio de animales. Sin embargo, el terreno del templo no debía ser el lugar para eso, ni siquiera en el atrio exterior de los gentiles, donde probablemente se habían establecido. Ser santo es ser *apartar*. El templo, de todos los lugares, debía estar dedicado a la adoración de Dios, un espacio para todas las personas, y el ruido de las multitudes que intercambiaban era un obstáculo para la oración.

Ya sean grandes y ornamentados (como la Basílica de Letrán) o íntimos y humildes, ¿nuestros lugares de culto iluminan su función? Además, ¿reflejamos con nuestras acciones en estos espacios sagrados el amor de Cristo en cuya presencia estamos?

Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome

Ez 47:1-2, 8-9, 12 | 1 Cor 3:9c-11, 16-17 | Jn 2:13-22

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Although today's feast marks the dedication of one of the most important churches for Catholics, the Basilica of Saint John Lateran, it's ultimately not a celebration of a building, but a celebration of all members of the Church. As Paul reminds us, we are "the temple of God" and the Spirit of God dwells in us. We see in the Gospel that Jesus has immense love for the temple and wishes to protect it. He uses a whip made from cords to drive out the money-changers, telling them, "Stop making my Father's house a marketplace." So, too, he loves and cherishes his Body, the Church – the place his presence dwells. Today's feast invites us to consider our love and zeal for the Church. As our love for the Lord grows, we will grow to love what our Savior loves.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Our first reading offers a beautiful image that can help us understand our mission as disciples. The prophet Ezekiel has a vision of the temple with water flowing out of it. Wherever the water flowed, there was abundant life, including "every sort of living creature," "abundant fish," and "fruit trees of every kind" whose "leaves shall not fade, nor the fruit fail." Since we are God's temple, Ezekiel's vision invites us to be sources of life-giving water, nourishment, and healing for the world around us. A powerful way to evangelize is simply to strive to be conduits of goodness in the world, right where we are. When others are lost in desolation, how can we offer a drink to quench their spiritual thirst? When people around us are hungry, how can we offer physical or spiritual food to ease their hunger? Where there is division, how do we bring healing and hope? Through these actions, we give others a taste of the goodness that life with God offers.

PRAY

At every Mass, during the Prayer of the Faithful, we pray for the needs of the Church first. This is intentional – as the Church is the Bride of Christ. Pay particular attention to what we pray at this moment and consider how you can show your love for the Church by praying for her and for the needs of the Church throughout the world in your personal prayer this week.

St. Stanislaus Kostka – November 13

In September, we highlighted two young men who just became Saints, St. Carlos Acutis and St. Pier Giorgio Frasseti. This week, we have another young saint to celebrate. St. Stanislaus Kostka, SJ, who was only 17 years old when he died in 1568.

Stanislaus was born in October 1550 in Rostkowo, Poland. His father was a statesman and wanted all seven of his sons to follow in his footsteps. Stanislaus, his second born, was different. He was attracted to the faith rather than to politics. He was sent to the Jesuit college in Vienna. As a student, his religious calling was confirmed, and he was determined to join the Jesuit order. He knew his father would furiously object and likely bring political trouble to the Jesuits in Vienna if he joined there. He decided to travel to Bavaria, Germany, over 400 miles away, and he did so on foot.

His brothers set out after him when they learned of his plans. They were not able to overtake Stanislaus, though, and he arrived in Bavaria. He stayed there for a month and was told he would need to travel to Rome and see the general of the order to gain admittance. He arrived in Rome in October 1567, exhausted. Seven days later, he was accepted as a novice in the Society of Jesus.

Stanislaus fell ill ten months later, in August, with a high fever. He begged the Blessed Virgin to allow him to celebrate her glorious Assumption (August 15) in heaven with her. He died that morning.

Since his death, St. Stanislaus has been an inspiration to young people in the pursuit of holiness. Pope St. John Paul II noted his influence and stated in a 1988 visit to his tomb, "I have been walking for many years of my life, since my childhood years, not just my youth, I walked together with this patron saint of youth, especially in Poland. And I also walked here in Rome, being close to it, as a student at the Belgian College. Almost every day, I came to pray to St. Stanislaus Kostka, to pray to him and to seek spiritual enlightenment and help from him. Many young students of different nationalities, from different colleges, had the same habit."

St. Stanislaus Kostka, pray for us. Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us!

San Estanislao Kostka – 13 de noviembre

En septiembre, destacamos a dos jóvenes que acaban de convertirse en santos, San Carlos Acutis y San Pier Giorgio Frasseti. Esta semana, tenemos otro santo joven para celebrar. San Estanislao Kostka, SJ, que tenía solo 17 años cuando murió en 1568.

Stanislaus nació en octubre de 1550 en Rostkowo, Polonia. Su padre era un estadista y quería que sus siete hijos siguieran sus pasos. Stanislaus, su segundo hijo, era diferente. Se sintió atraído por la fe más que por la política. Fue enviado al colegio jesuita de Viena. Como estudiante, su vocación religiosa se confirmó y estaba decidido a unirse a la orden jesuita. Sabía que su padre se opondría furiosamente y probablemente traería problemas políticos a los jesuitas en Viena si se unía allí. Decidió viajar a Baviera, Alemania, a más de 400 millas de distancia, y lo hizo a pie.

Sus hermanos partieron tras él cuando se enteraron de sus planes. Sin embargo, no pudieron alcanzar a Estanislao y llegó a Baviera. Permaneció allí durante un mes y le dijeron que tendría que viajar a Roma y ver al general de la orden para ser admitido. Llegó a Roma en octubre de 1567, exhausto. Siete días después, fue aceptado como novicio en la Compañía de Jesús.

Estanislao enfermó diez meses después, en agosto, con fiebre alta. Le rogó a la Santísima Virgen que le permitiera celebrar su gloriosa Asunción (15 de agosto) en el cielo con ella. Murió esa mañana.

Desde su muerte, San Estanislao ha sido una inspiración para los jóvenes en la búsqueda de la santidad. El Papa San Juan Pablo II notó su influencia y declaró en una visita a su tumba en 1988: "He estado caminando durante muchos años de mi vida, desde mis años de infancia, no solo desde mi juventud, caminé junto con este santo patrón de la juventud, especialmente en Polonia. Y también caminé aquí en Roma, estando cerca de ella, como estudiante en el Colegio Belga. Casi todos los días, venía a rezar a San Estanislao Kostka, a rezarle y a buscar su iluminación espiritual y su ayuda. Muchos jóvenes estudiantes de diferentes nacionalidades, de diferentes universidades, tenían el mismo hábito".

San Estanislao Kostka, ruega por nosotros. ¡Inmaculado Corazón de María, ruega por nosotros!

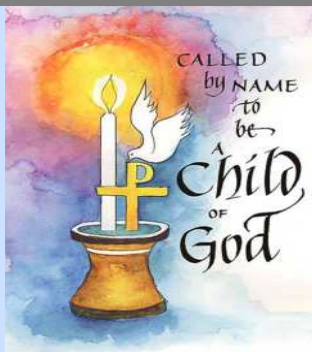

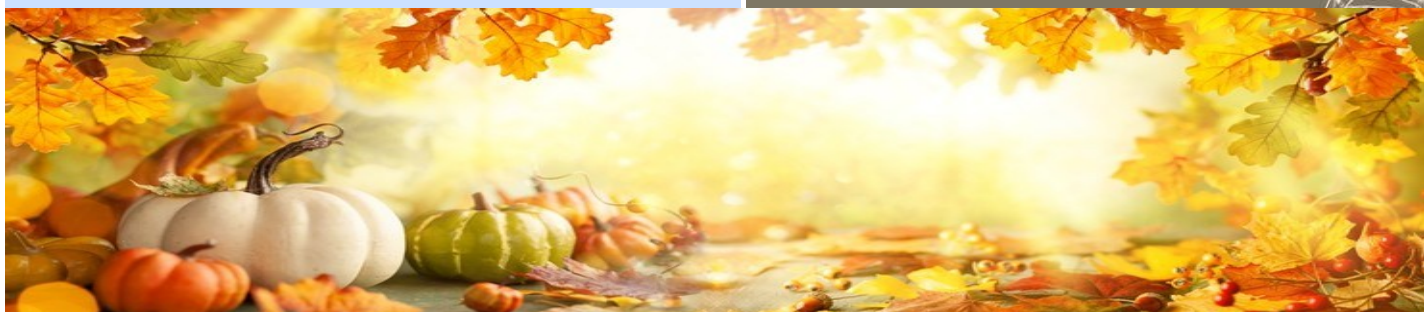

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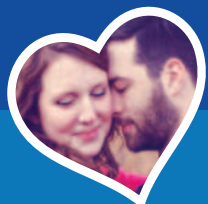
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
