Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

What kind of King is Jesus? How do you envision him? Remembering that they were promised a king from the line of David, the Israelites hoped for a Messiah who would set their political problems aright and bring about a worldly kingdom of Judaic power. Even Psalm 122 seems to describe this type of ruler. Luke's Gospel today shreds that image after the whip of the Roman soldiers tore at Jesus' flesh. Still, the Romans flaunted the traditional notion with their ironic inscription above King Jesus' crown of thorns. Soldiers and ordinary people jeered the royal title at him. Yet the throne of Jesus was the cross of Christ, from which he dispensed kingly mercy and justice toward the humble criminal who shared his execution. Writing to the Colossians, Saint Paul describes the truth about Jesus and his kingship, using words like fullness, peace, and forgiveness. So, let us go rejoicing!

So, as we go rejoicing this week, we enter into Advent next Sunday. Even though Advent is not as restrictive as Lent we should use this time to prepare for the coming of Christ Jesus for the first time. As we enter Advent we should find time to increase our prayer time, and realize that the real purpose of Christmas is Christ's birth. It is also a good time to look for ways to pray together with family.

Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us.

¿Qué clase de Rey es Jesús? ¿Cómo te lo imaginas? Incluso el salmo 122 parece describir este tipo de gobernante. El Evangelio de Lucas de hoy destruye esta imagen después de que el látigo de los soldados romanos desgarrara la carne de Jesús. Sin embargo, los romanos hicieron alarde de esa noción tradicional con la inscripción irónica en el letrero que pusieron sobre la cabeza de Jesús que está coronada con espinas. Los soldados y la gente de a pie se burlaban de su título de realeza. Sin embargo, el trono de Jesús era la cruz de Cristo, desde la que administraba misericordia y justicia majestuosa hacía el criminal humilde que compartía su ejecución. Al escribir a los colosenses, san Pablo describe la verdad sobre Jesús y su realeza, utilizando palabras como plenitud, paz y perdón. Así que ivamos a alegrarnos!

Así, mientras nos alegramos esta semana, entramos en el Adviento el próximo domingo. Aunque el Adviento no es tan restrictivo como la Cuaresma, debemos usar este tiempo para prepararnos para la venida de Cristo Jesús por primera vez. Al entrar en el Adviento deberíamos encontrar tiempo para aumentar nuestro tiempo de oración, y darnos cuenta de que el verdadero propósito de la Navidad es el nacimiento de Cristo. También es un buen momento para buscar formas de rezar juntos con la familia.

Inmaculado Corazón de María, ruega por nosotros.

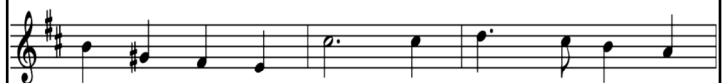

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

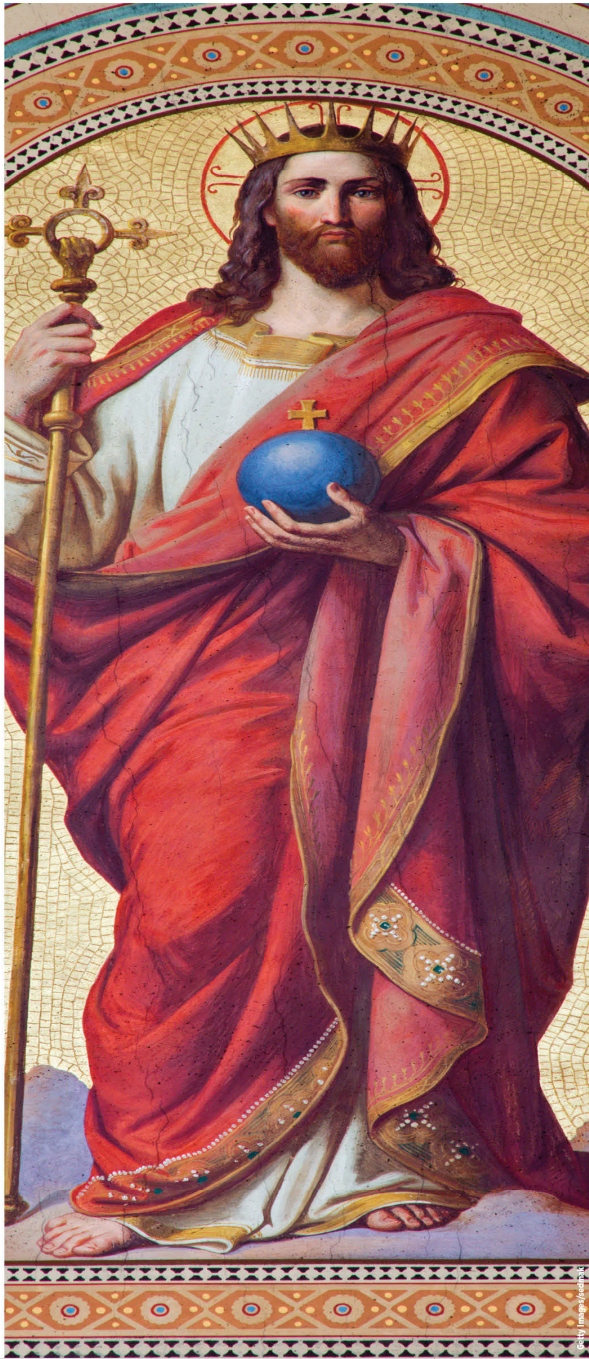
Did you watch Queen Elizabeth's funeral procession? The Imperial State Crown that sat atop her coffin is "made of gold and set with 2,868 diamonds, 17 sapphires, 11 emeralds, 269 pearls, and 4 rubies," according to the Historic Royal Palaces website. It had been made for her father, King George VI, for his 1937 coronation. It is hard to reconcile this bejeweled crown with the crown of thorns worn by Jesus at his crucifixion. Yet we recognize the crucified Christ as the king of kings, the firstborn of creation, above "thrones or dominions or principalities or powers." As we conclude the liturgical year, we are reminded that the cross, not the crown, is the primary symbol of Christ's power. By embracing the cross - through service, sacrifice and recognizing Jesus as the king of our lives - we can help bring about his kingdom.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

It can be easy to distance ourselves from the two condemned criminals crucified alongside Jesus, much the way we might write off the prisoners in our midst today. Yet Luke's telling reveals their humanity and our shared human nature. One reacts as any of us might, telling Jesus to "save himself." The other speaks words of faith, recognizing Jesus as the Son of God, our true king of the universe. As we prepare to enter Advent, let us ask God for the grace to recognize Jesus as our king. Soon we will be swept up in the Christmas countdown. By placing Christ, the newborn king, at the center of our lives, we can in turn help ourselves and those close to us slow down and experience Advent in such a way so as to fully prepare for his coming.

PRAY This week, make the words of the second criminal your prayer: "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom."

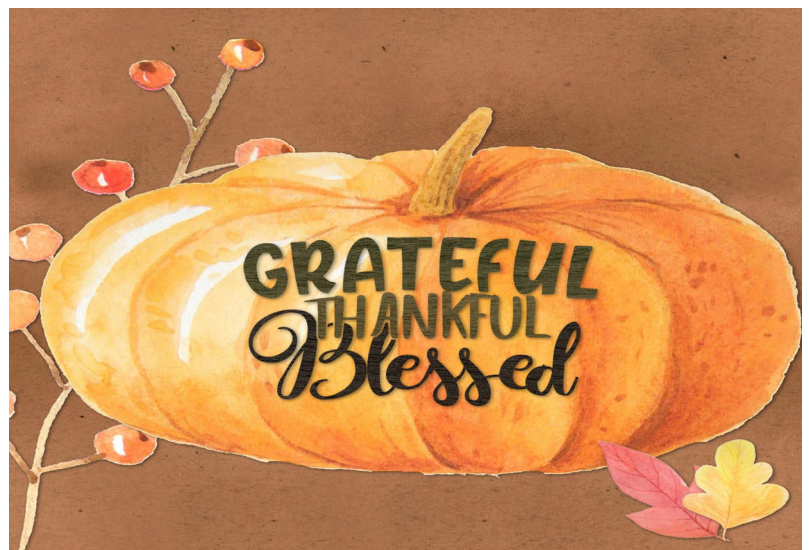

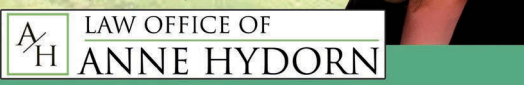
