Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

The prophetic writings we hear in today's scriptures call us to rejoice and celebrate the goodness of God. Zephaniah, Isaiah, Saint Paul, and John the Baptist in Luke's Gospel all follow the rich tradition of the Biblical prophets, a tradition that reaches full expression in Jesus. The prophets warn that human failings have truly disastrous consequences. All are summoned to repent, and to change their lives.

Today we hear the Good News that God's gracious love exceeds and overcomes all human corruption. God has not given up on us. Indeed, God keeps pursuing us, and eagerly seeks to reconcile with us. God's initiative to set the world aright culminates with Jesus, whose coming John the Baptist announces. John's prophetic message summons us to join in God's reconciling work, by living generously and justly in our daily lives. As we rejoice in God's grace, we then extend the fruits of this grace to all.

During the time of Advent we should prepare remembering the time of Christ's first coming and why God sent His only son to save us. It is a good time to go to Confession, spend time in Adoration and find time daily to open our hearts hearing God speak to us.

Another reminder that on Friday, December 17, we will have group caroling in the Church. Come and join in Christmas carols.

Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us.

### Evangelio

Lc 3, 10-18

tiene ninguna, y quien tenga comida, que haga lo  
mismo".

También acudían a él los publicanos para que los  
bautizara, y le preguntaban: "Maestro, ¿qué  
tenemos que hacer nosotros?" El les decía: "No  
cobren más de lo establecido". Unos soldados le  
preguntaron: "Y nosotros, ¿qué tenemos que  
hacer?" El les dijo: "No extorsionen a nadie, ni  
denuncien a nadie falsamente, sino conténtense  
con su salario".

Como el pueblo estaba en expectación y todos  
pensaban que quizá Juan era el Mesías, Juan los  
sacó de dudas, diciéndoles: "Es cierto que yo  
bautizo con agua, pero ya viene otro más  
poderoso que yo, a quien no merezco desatarle las  
correas de sus sandalias. El los bautizará con el  
Espíritu Santo y con fuego.

Él tiene el bieldo en la mano para separar el trigo  
de la paja; guardará el trigo en su granero y

quemará la paja en un fuego que no se extingue".  
Con éstas y otras muchas exhortaciones  
anunciaba al pueblo la buena nueva.

Even tax collectors came to be baptized and they  
said to him,  
"Teacher, what should we do?"  
He answered them,  
"Stop collecting more than what is prescribed."  
Soldiers also asked him,  
"And what is it that we should do?"  
He told them,  
"Do not practice extortion,  
do not falsely accuse anyone,  
and be satisfied with your wages."  
Now the people were filled with expectation,  
and all were asking in their hearts whether John

might be the Christ.

John answered them all, saying,  
"I am baptizing you with water,  
but one mightier than I is coming.  
I am not worthy to loosen the thongs  
of his sandals.  
He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.  
His winnowing fan is in his hand to clear his  
threshing floor and to gather the wheat into his  
barn,  
but the chaff he will burn with unquenchable  
fire."  
Exhorting them in many other ways,  
he preached good news to the people.

## Third Sunday of Advent

Zep 3:14-18a | Phil 4:4-7 | Lk 3:10-18

### GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Although spontaneous outbursts of joy are not part of our liturgy, today's readings alert us that we have much reason to rejoice. Even in times of anxiety, we can rely on the words of St. Paul, who writes that we can rest assured that "the peace of God that surpasses all understanding will guard [our] hearts and minds in Christ Jesus." As we prepare for his coming during this Advent season, we don't need to leap out of our pews and make a show of our praise (but go for it, if that's your style!). However, in our hearts and in our prayer, we can follow the psalmist's lead and "cry out with joy and gladness: for among you is the great and Holy One of Israel." We can praise God in many ways, through fervent prayer, simple acts of kindness and, as John the Baptist did so well, sharing the Good News.

### GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

"What should we do?" The crowds asked John the Baptist a deceptively simple question many of us wrestle with today. How do we prepare for Christ's coming? How should we spend the next hour, the day, the next year, the next five? John the Baptist answers without reservation: Share what you have. Don't be greedy. Do not falsely accuse others. In other words, get it together! The Lord is coming. Advent is a wonderful time to do just that, and St. Paul reminds us that we don't have to know all the answers. "The Lord is near," he writes, "Have no anxiety at all, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, make your requests known to God." Last week, the readings encouraged us to discern what is truly valuable in our lives as Christians. Today's readings encourage us to ask the Lord: "What should we do?" Just as John the Baptist showed the people how to prepare for Christ's coming, the Lord shows us how to live out and share our faith through the Scriptures and in the silence of prayer.

### ACTIONS Remember the last time you felt unadulterated joy?

For me it was when my son smacked a game-winning goal at a hockey game. As we move through Advent, we can reawaken a sense of childlike joy as we prepare to celebrate Christ among us. As you light the Advent candle, take time to share with one another something that gave you joy within the past week.
